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
Success Criteria I will talk about who is in the story. I will talk about what happened at the start, what happened in the middle and what happened

Sequencing

Sequencing means to put ideas in order. When you sequence a story you put events in the order they happened in the story. When you sequence pictures you put them in the order you think makes sense.

Helpful words: at the start, in the beginning, first, next, then, after that, later, finally, in the end
