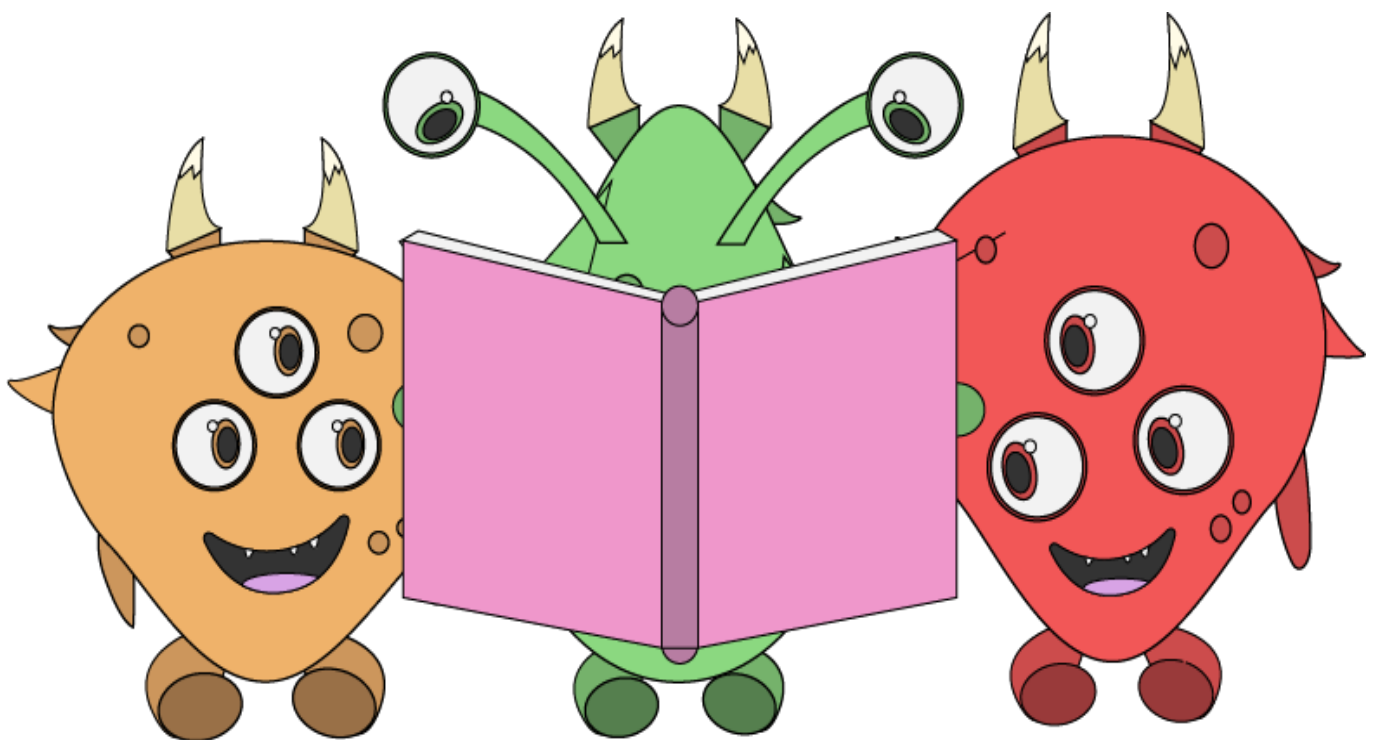


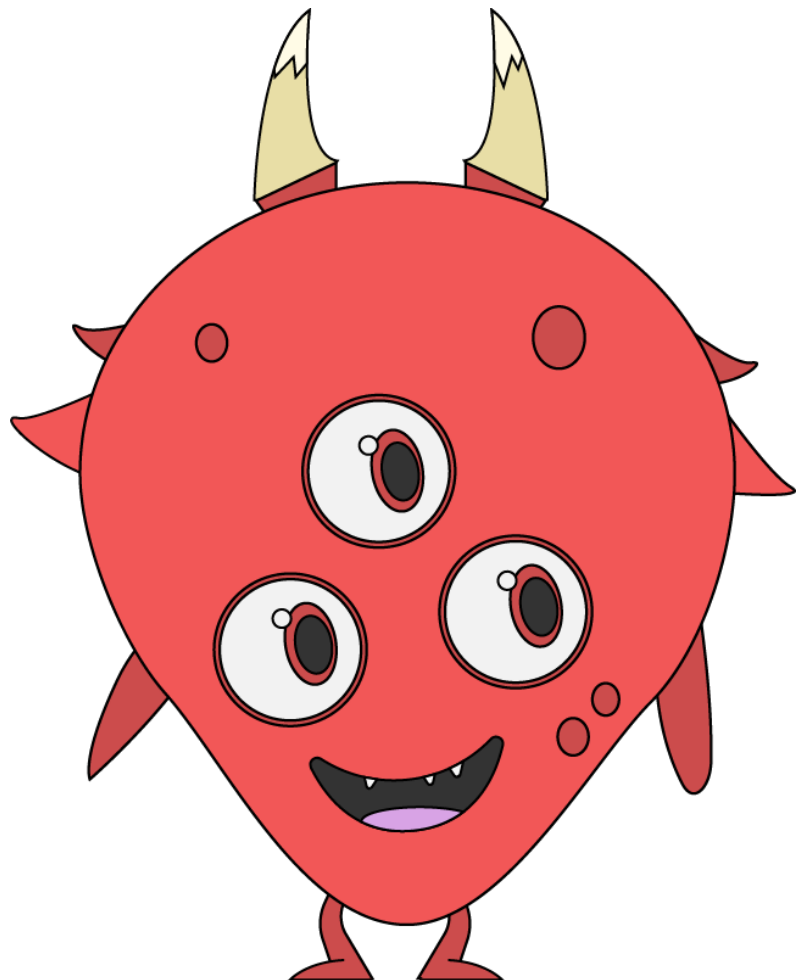
Learning Intention

I am learning about story grammar. Story grammar is each important element or part of a story.



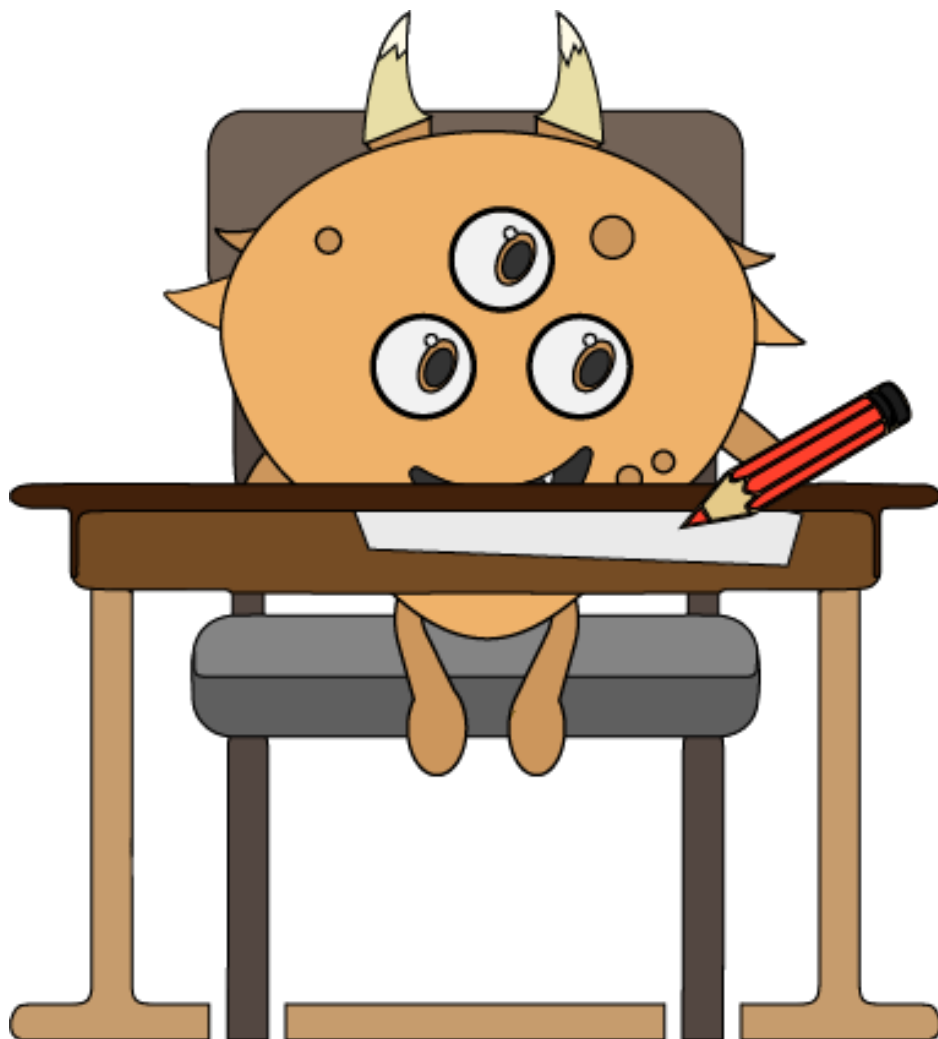
Success Criteria

Retelling

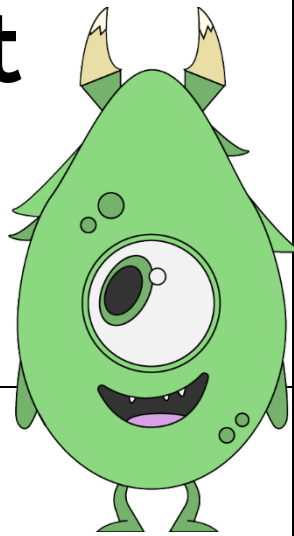
In a retell the ideas go in the order they happened in a story. You need to think, “What happened at the start, in the middle and at the end?”

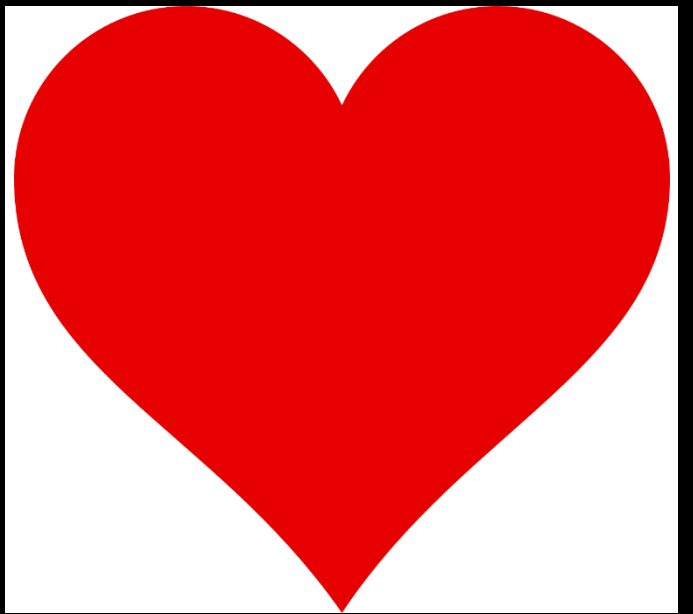
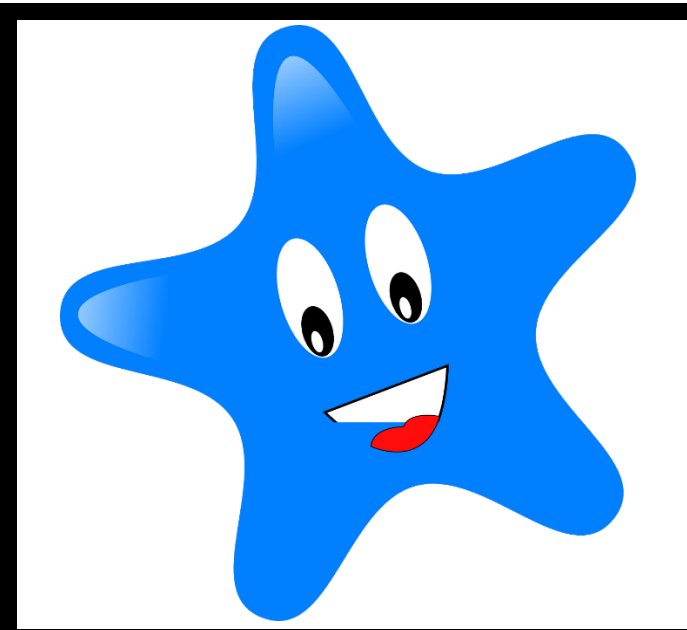
