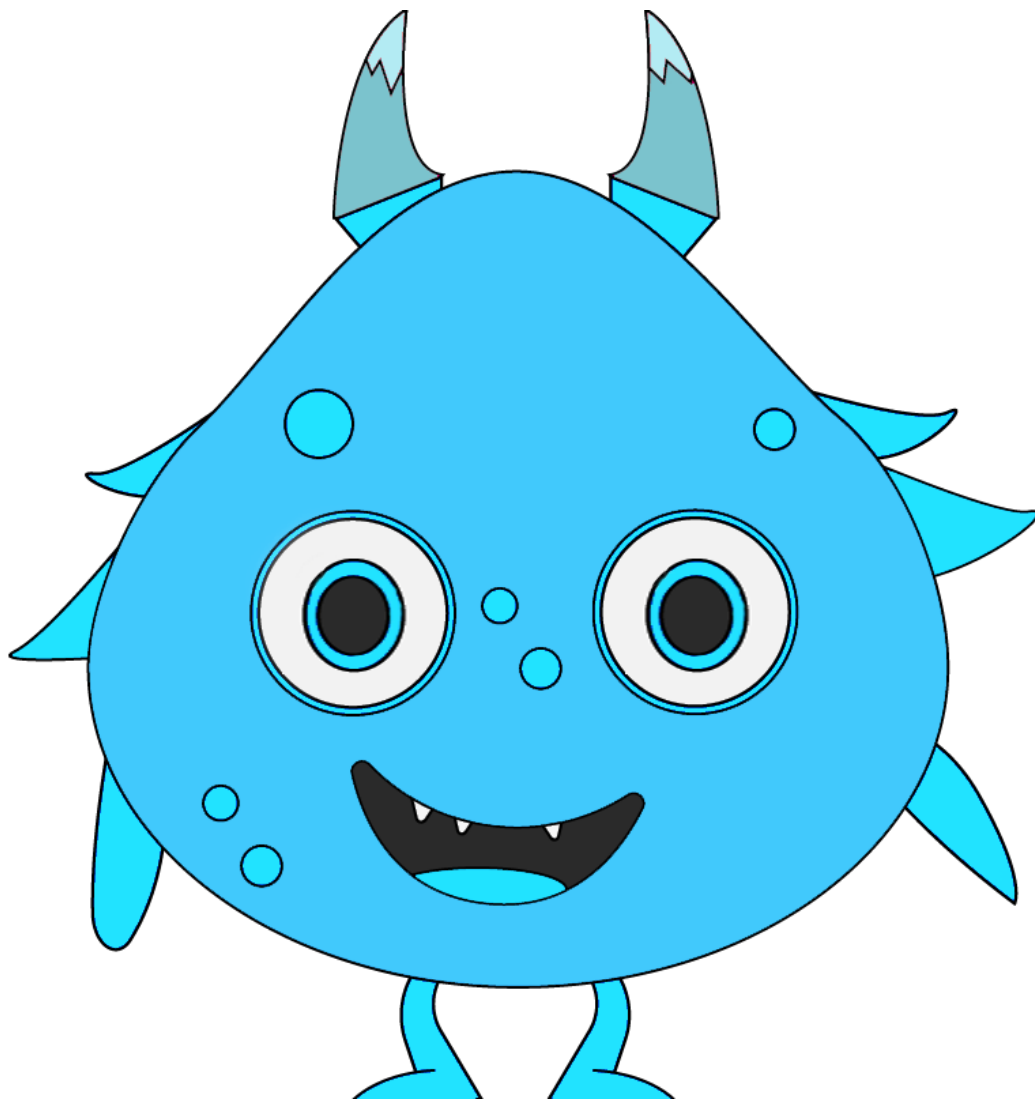


Learning Intention

different

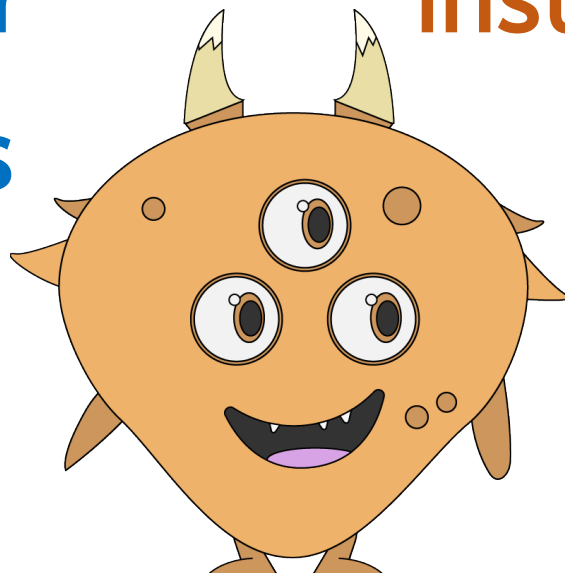
both
