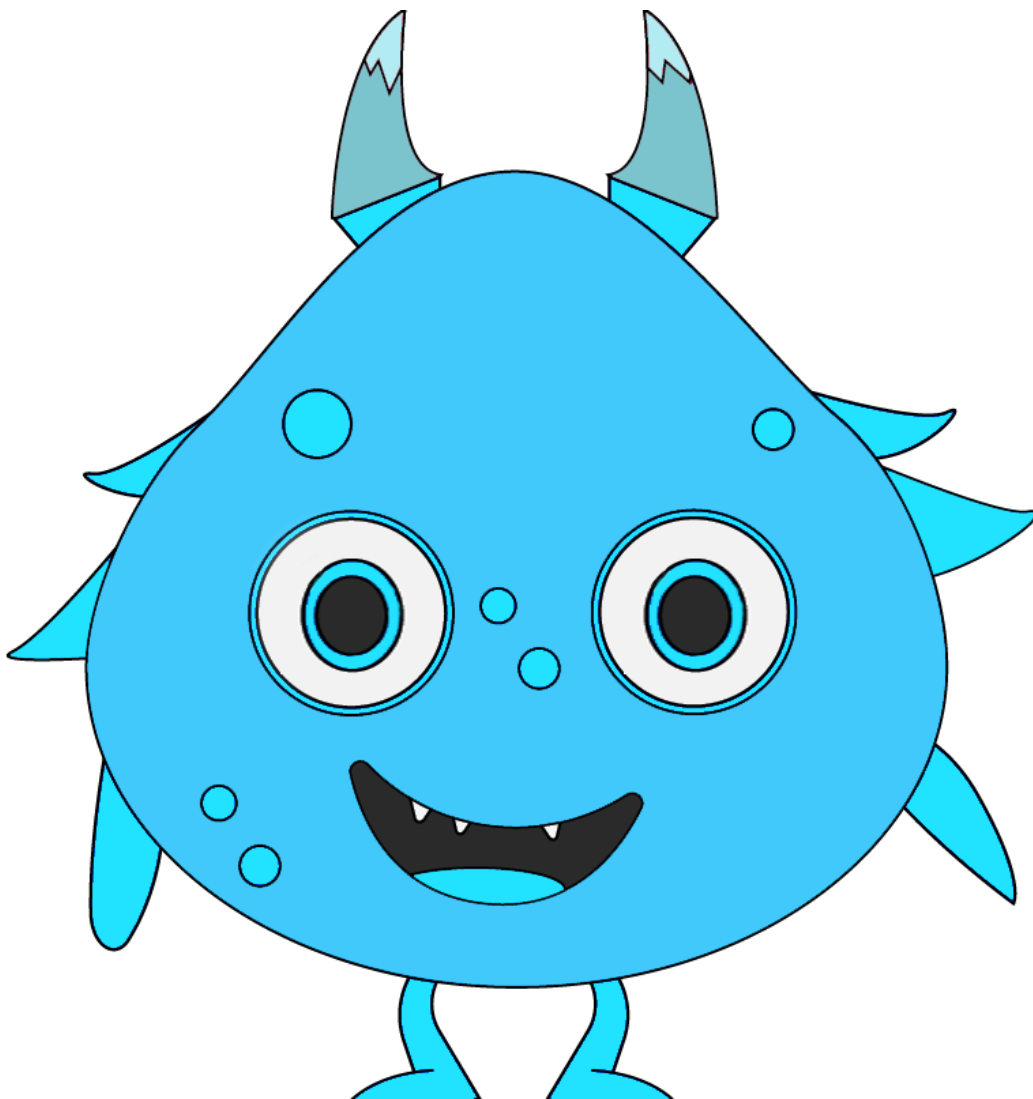

both

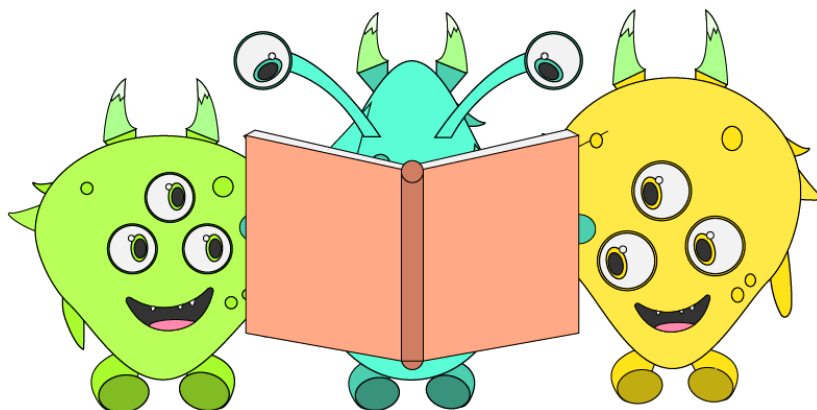
but

just as

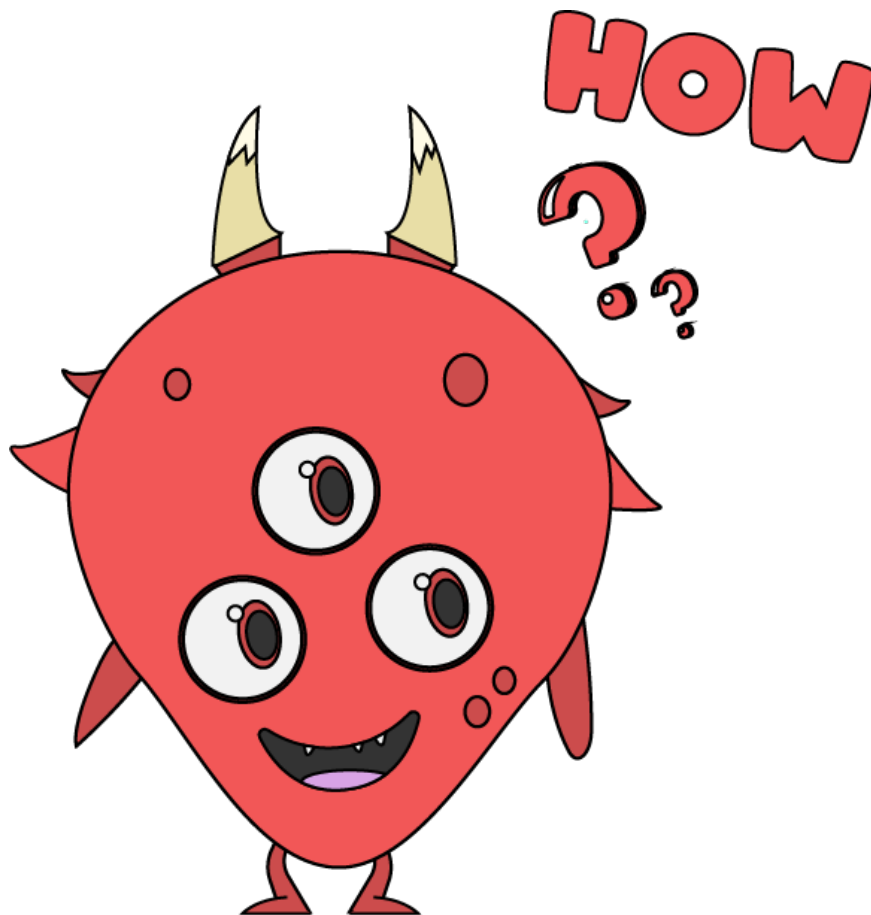
not the same



# Compare and Contrast

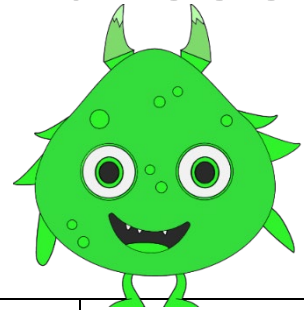
Comparing means to notice how two or more things are the same and different.
