





#### Fiction and Nonfiction

Nonfiction means true or factual. The ideas are not made up. The information is correct or accurate.




## **Contents Page**

A table of contents is a list at the start of the book.

The list tells you headings, or names of the chapters, or sections, of the book. It also tells you the page that section starts on. Headings are important because they help readers know the imporant idea in the part of the book.
