

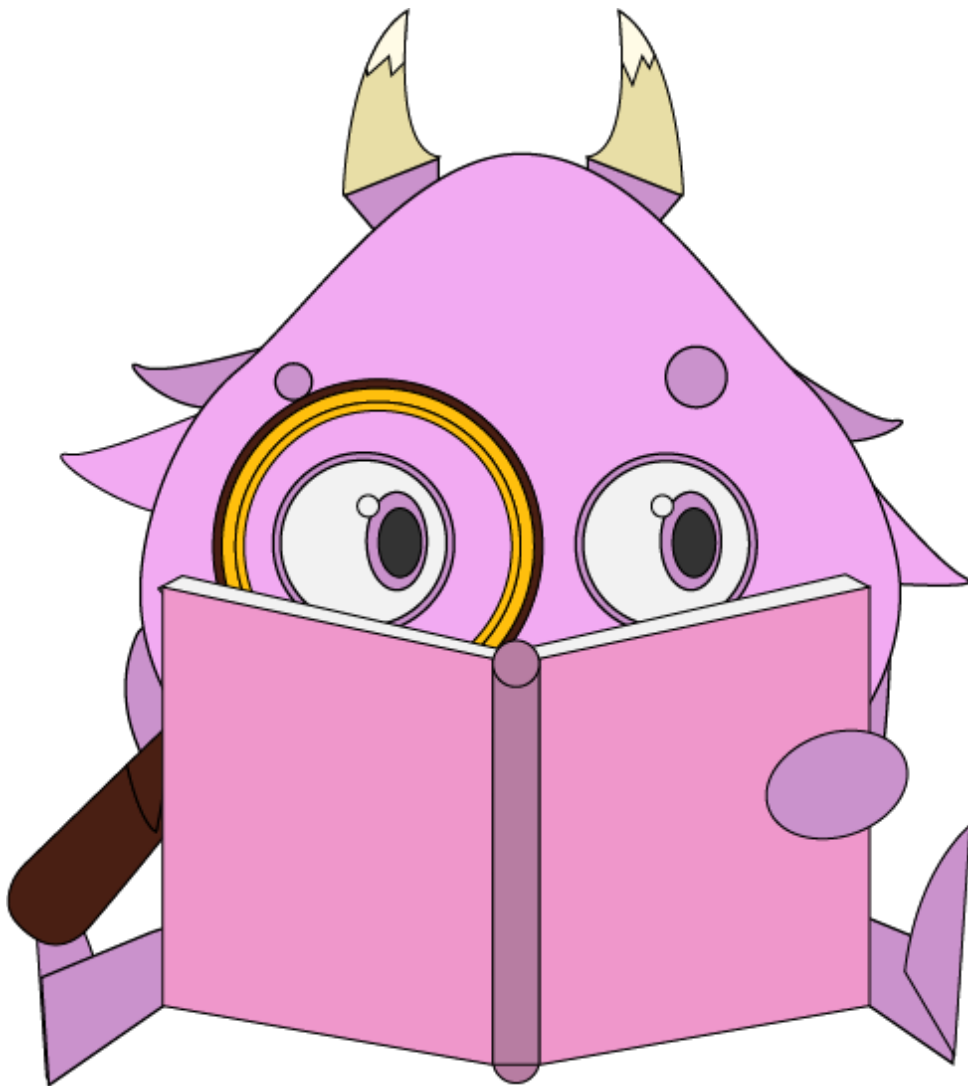

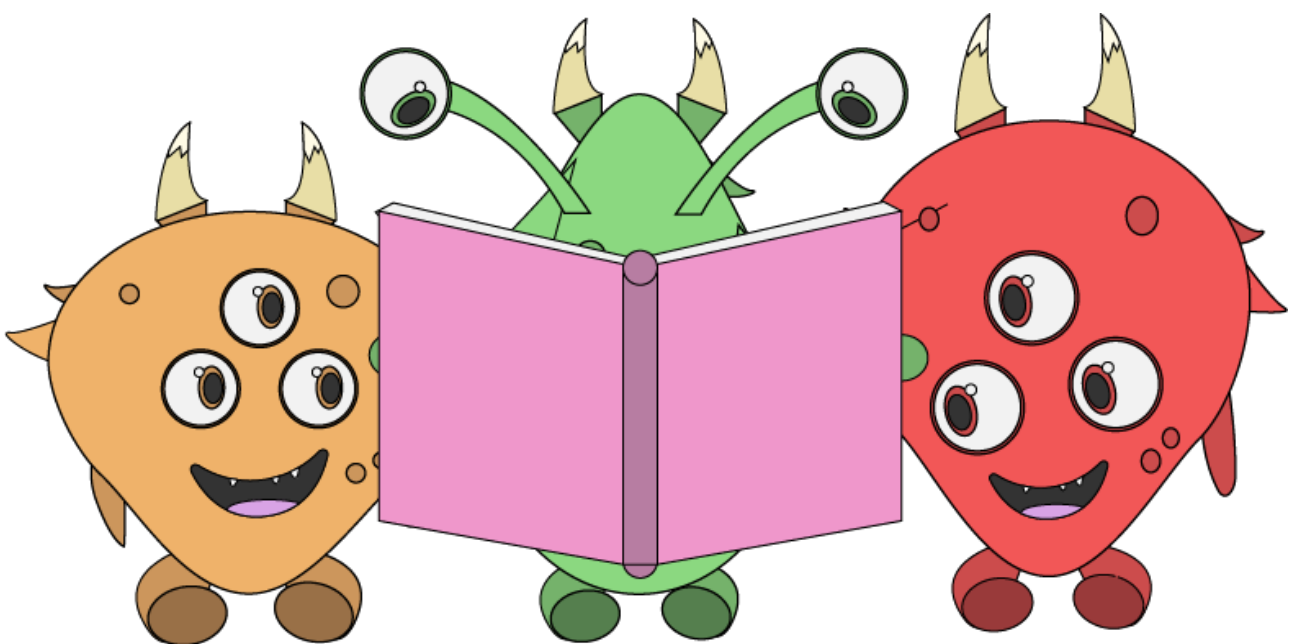
I will look at a text and find labels and captions. I will figure out which words are labels and which are captions.



Fiction and Nonfiction

Fiction means made up or invented. The ideas are not true, but come from a person's imagination.

Nonfiction means true or factual. The ideas are not made up. The information is correct or accurate.

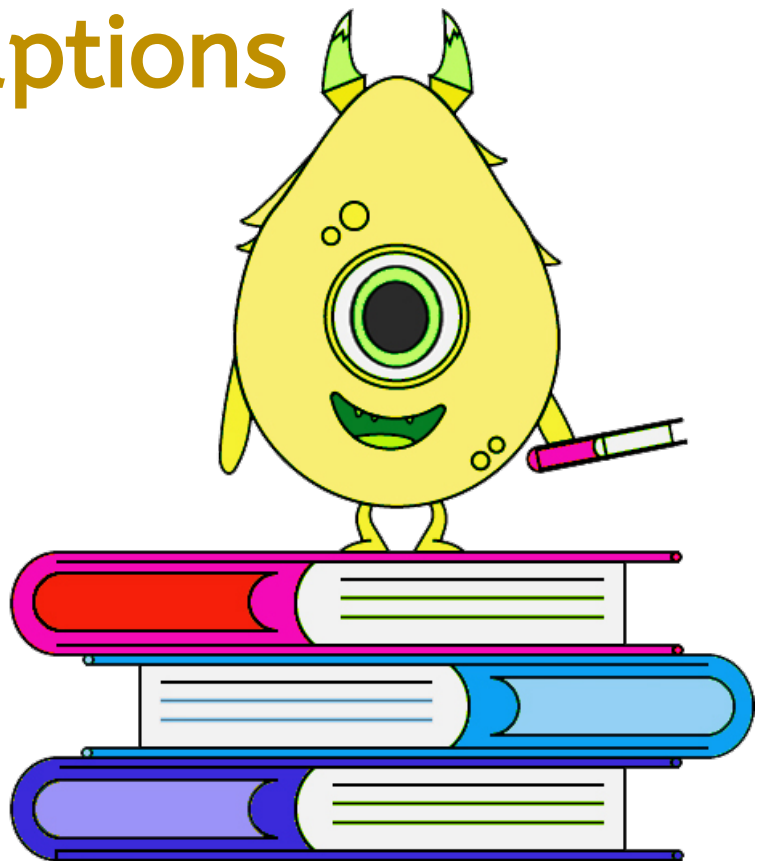


Labels and Captions

A label is a word, or a small group of words which tell you what something is, or what it is called.

A caption is a title or a small group of words which tells you about a picture or image.

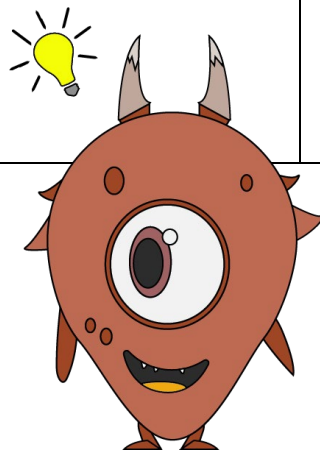
Labels and captions help you to understand the ideas you are reading about.

Females lay approximately four white chalky eggs.

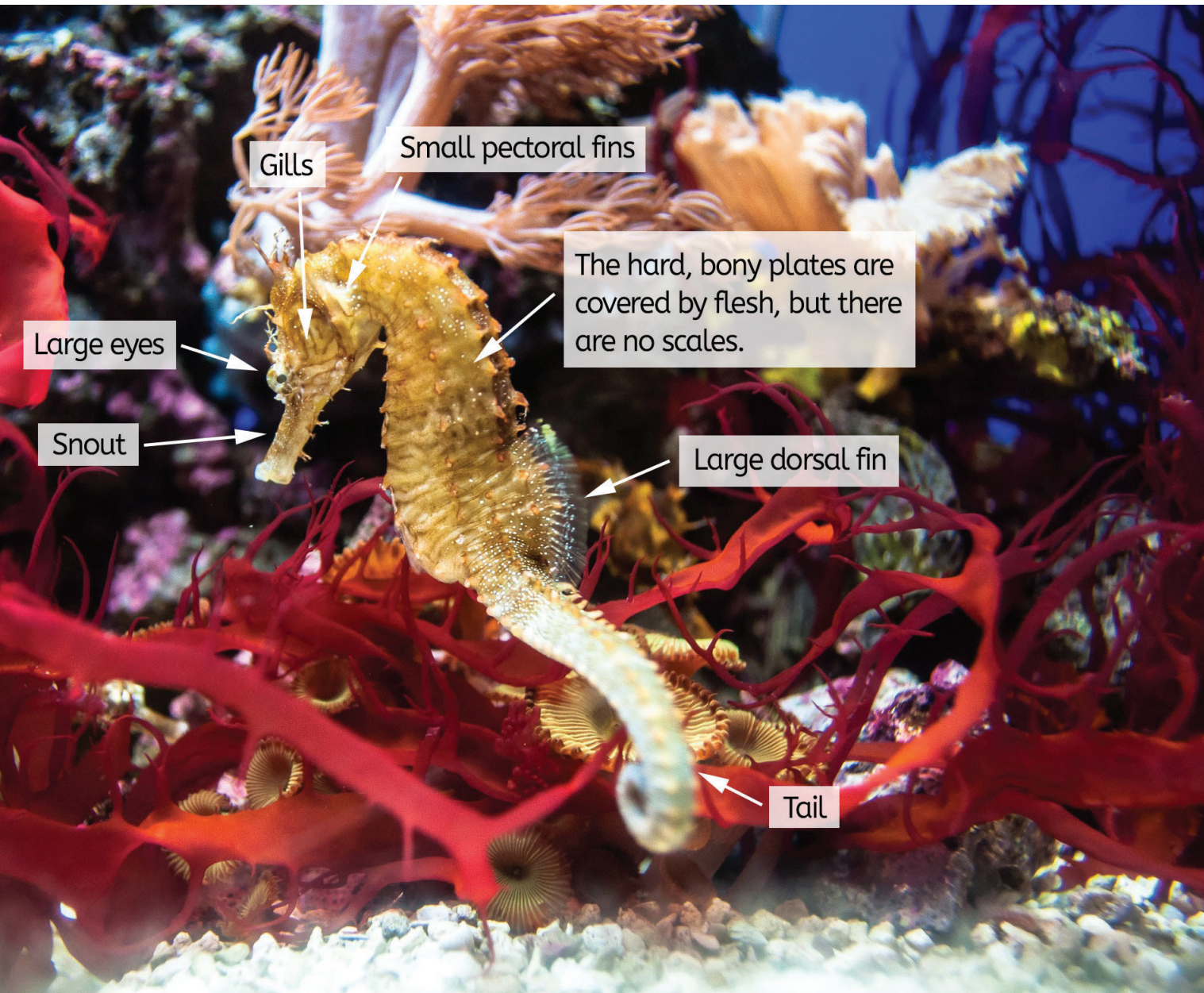

Stork nests are built on top of a building or other structure, or high in a tree by a male and female.



Seahorses

The word seahorse means “horse caterpillar”.

Seahorses are fish. They breathe through gills and have small fins. They also have a long snake-like tail used to grip grass or weeds when the water current is strong.

Seahorses have a long, thin snout used for finding food in small spaces. Seahorses cannot chew so food is sucked up like a vacuum cleaner.

Seahorses have excellent vision and interesting eyes. While one eye looks forwards the other can look backwards. This helps them find food.

Like many insects, seahorses have a skeleton on the outside of their body. This is called an exoskeleton. They can also change colour.

Did you know that the male seahorse has a pouch? The male can carry hundreds of eggs in his pouch.
