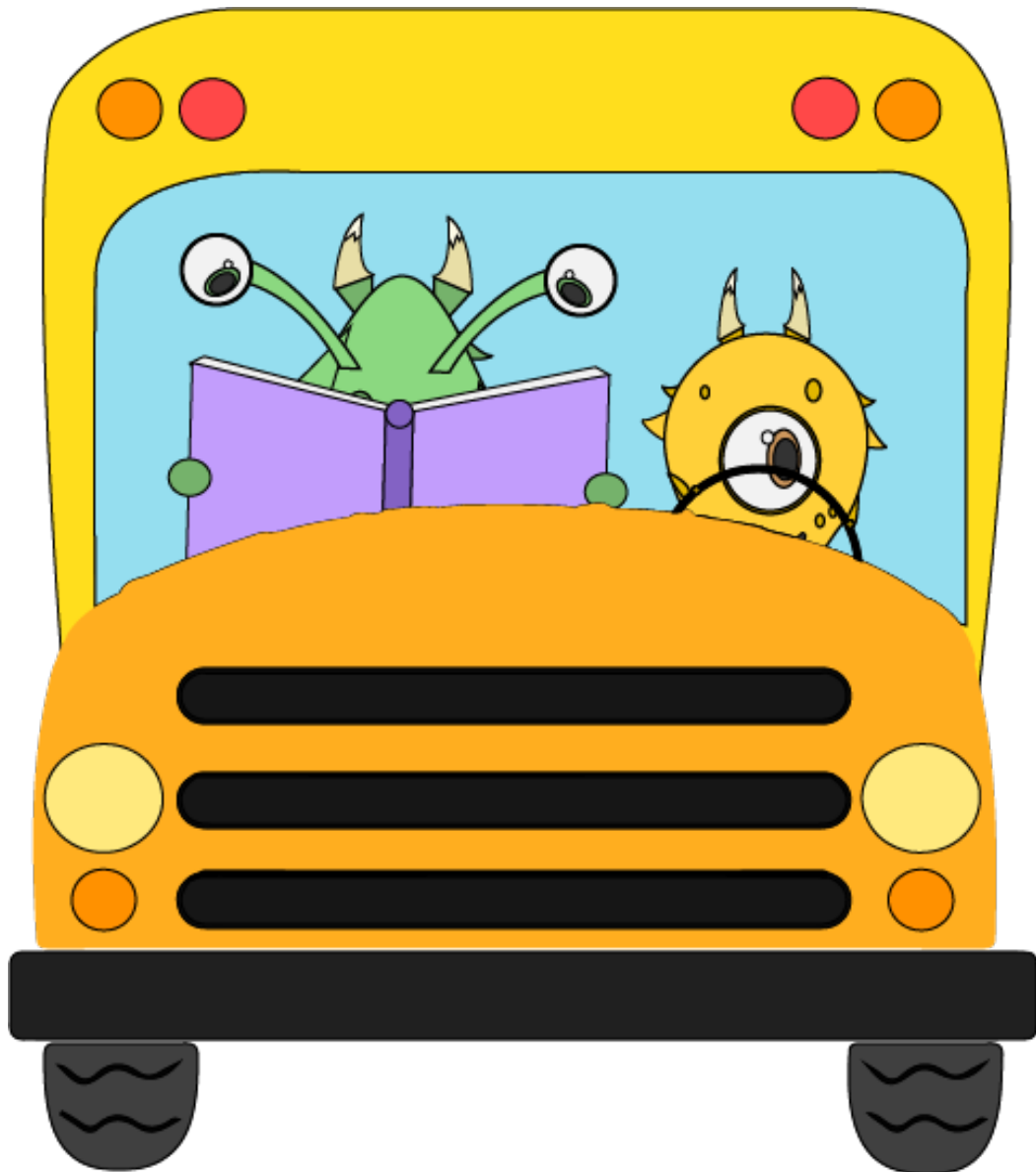


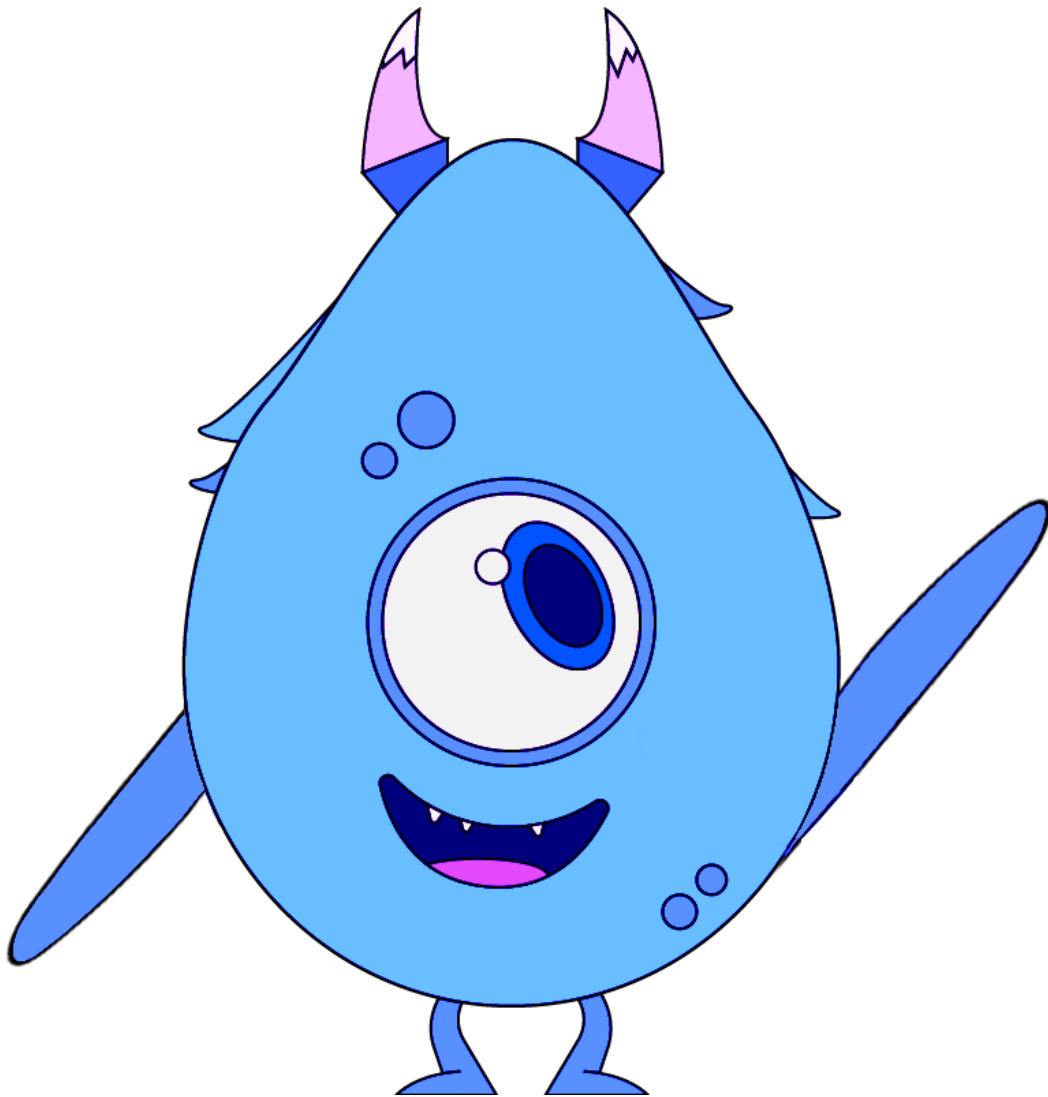

Success Criteria

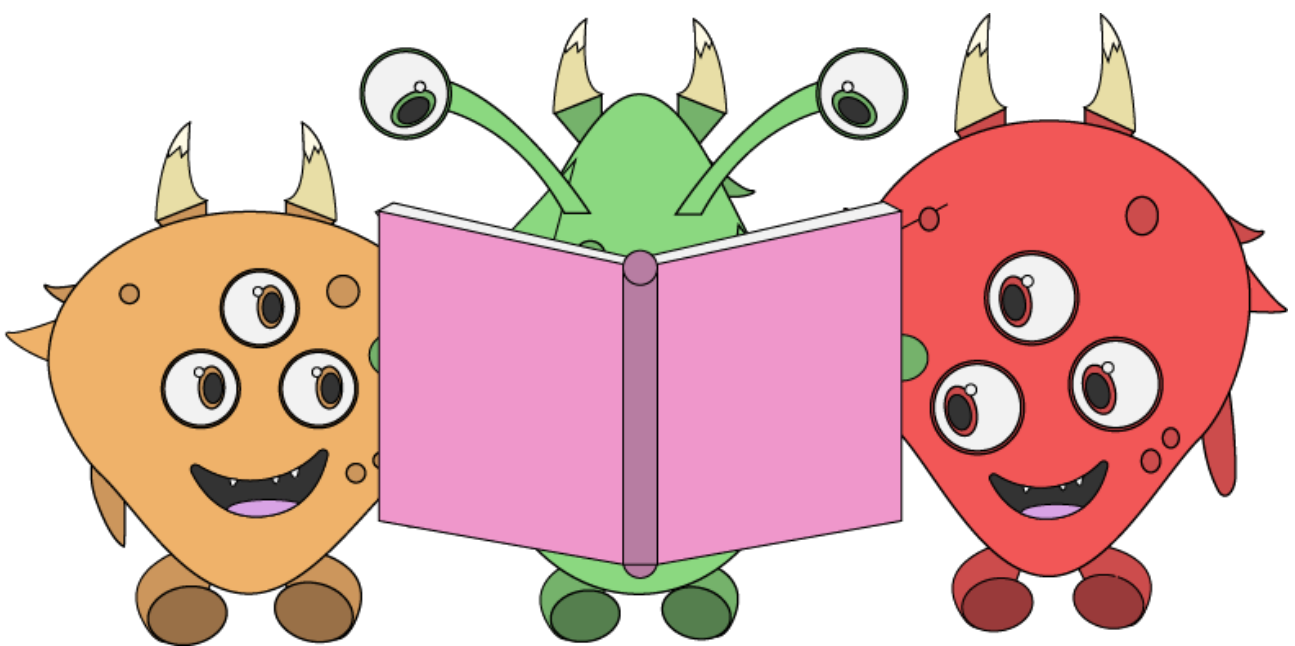
I will look at the glossary in a book. I will be able to tell others where the glossary is found and what job it does.



Fiction and Nonfiction

Fiction means made up or invented. The ideas are not true, but come from a person's imagination.

Nonfiction means true or factual. The ideas are not made up. The information is correct or accurate.



Glossary

A glossary is a special list of words and their meanings.

The glossary is found near the back of a book. The quickest way to find it is to close the book and open it up from the back cover. Go past the index and the glossary is next.

Readers use the glossary to check what words mean.
