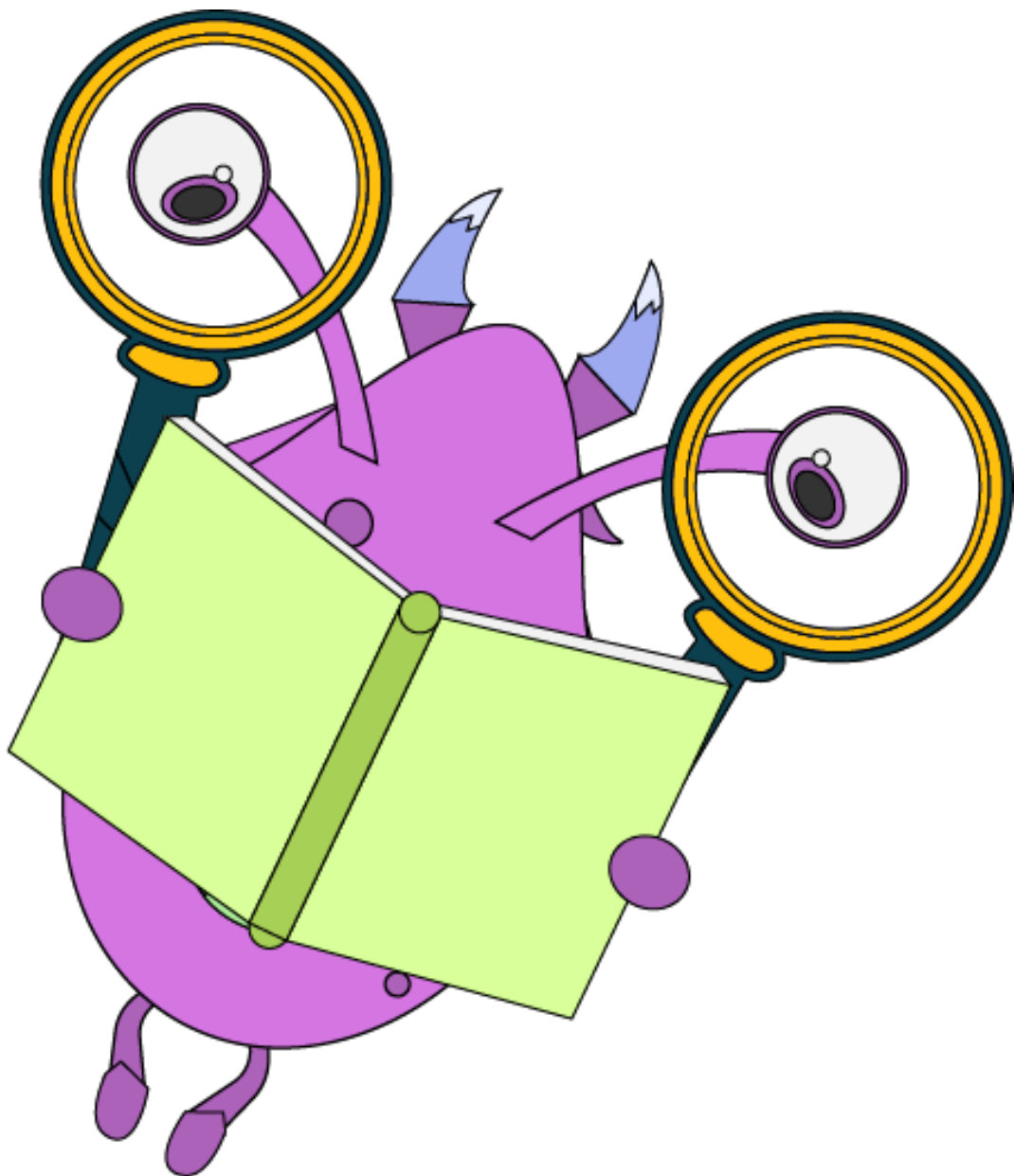


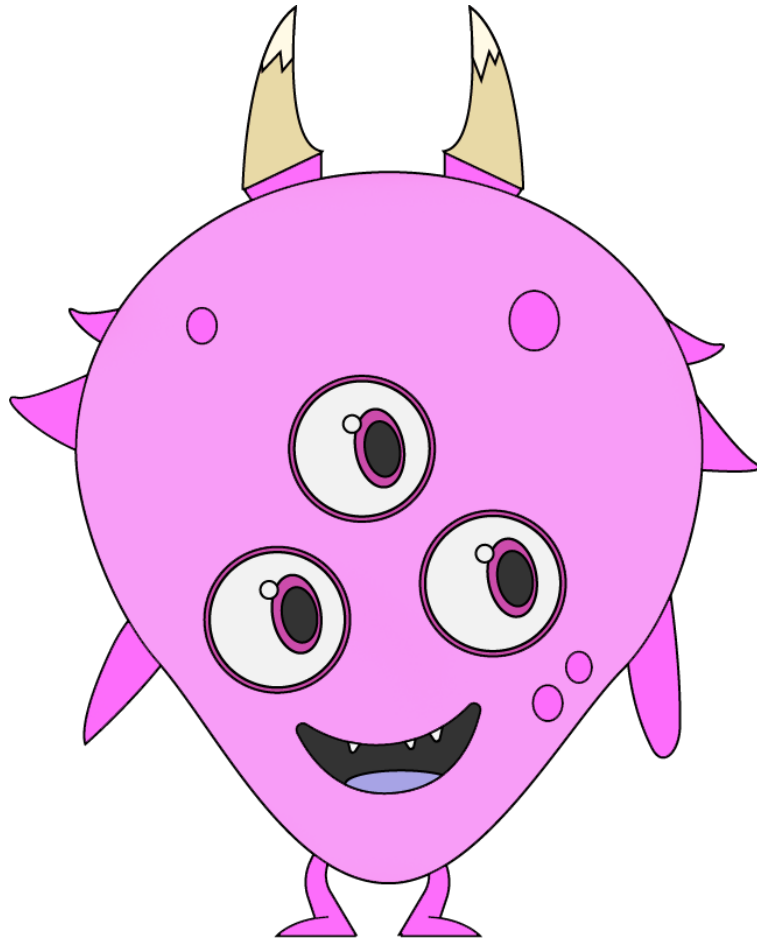

Success Criteria

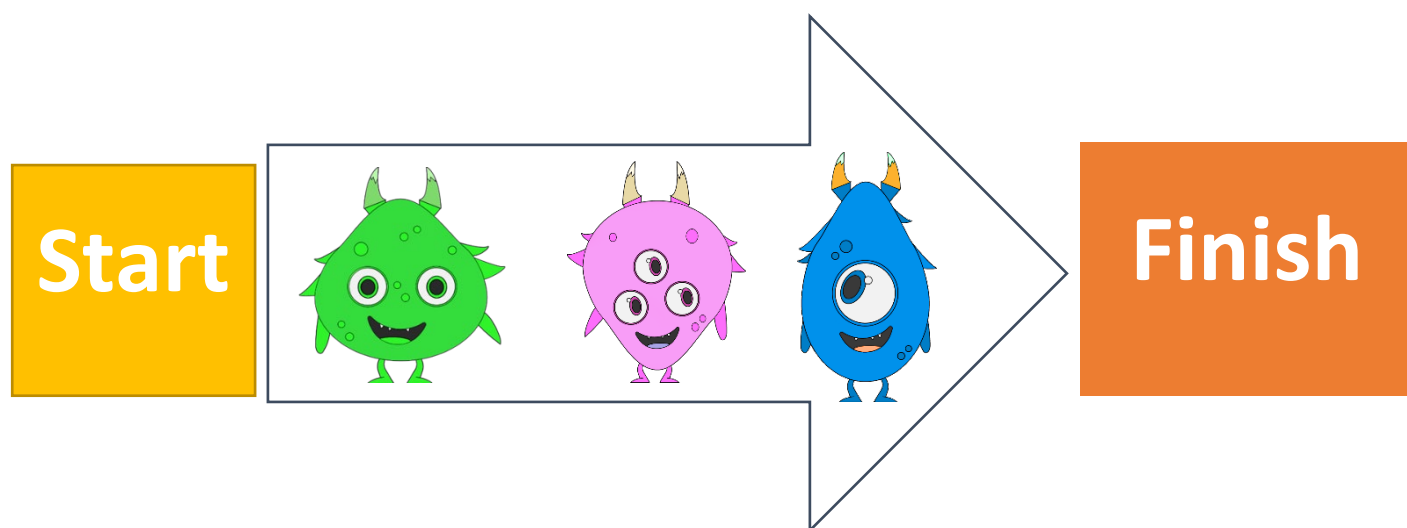
I will look at the words and pictures on a flowchart and talk about what the flowchart is showing me.

A flowchart shows the way things go or the order they happen. Lines or arrows help readers to know which way the ideas go.

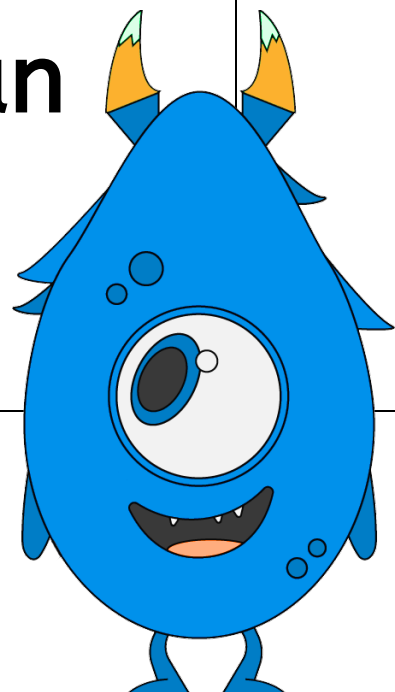


A flowchart might show words, numbers, pictures, boxes or other symbols, like arrows.

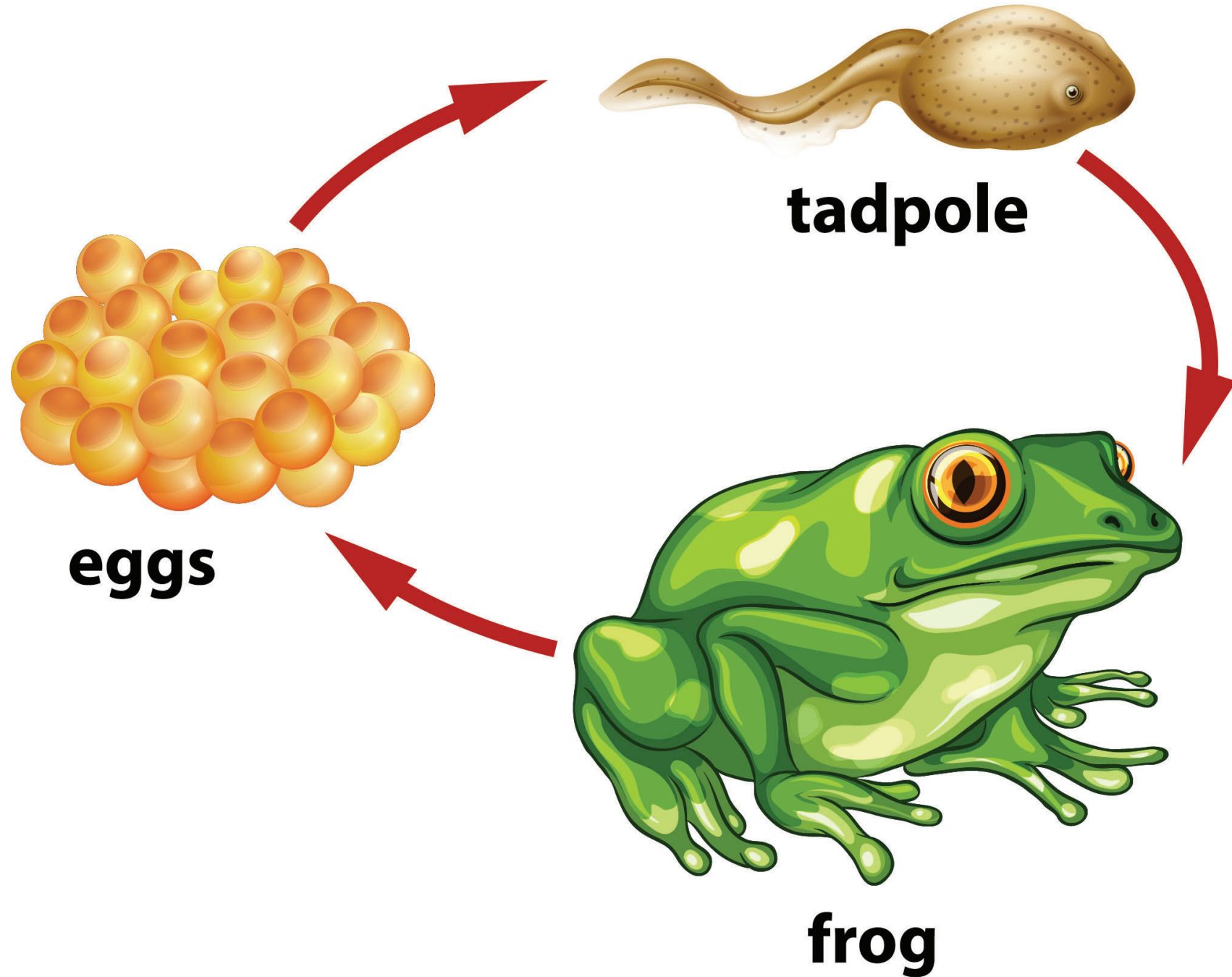

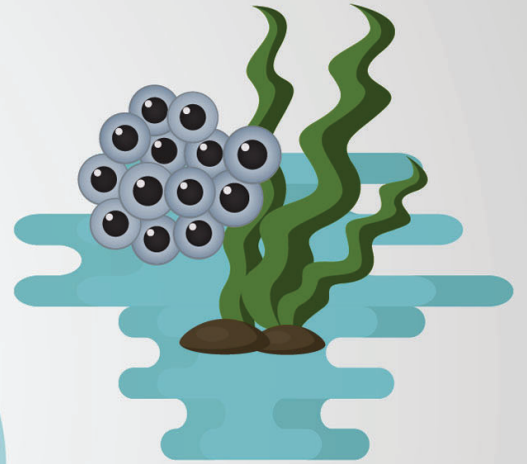


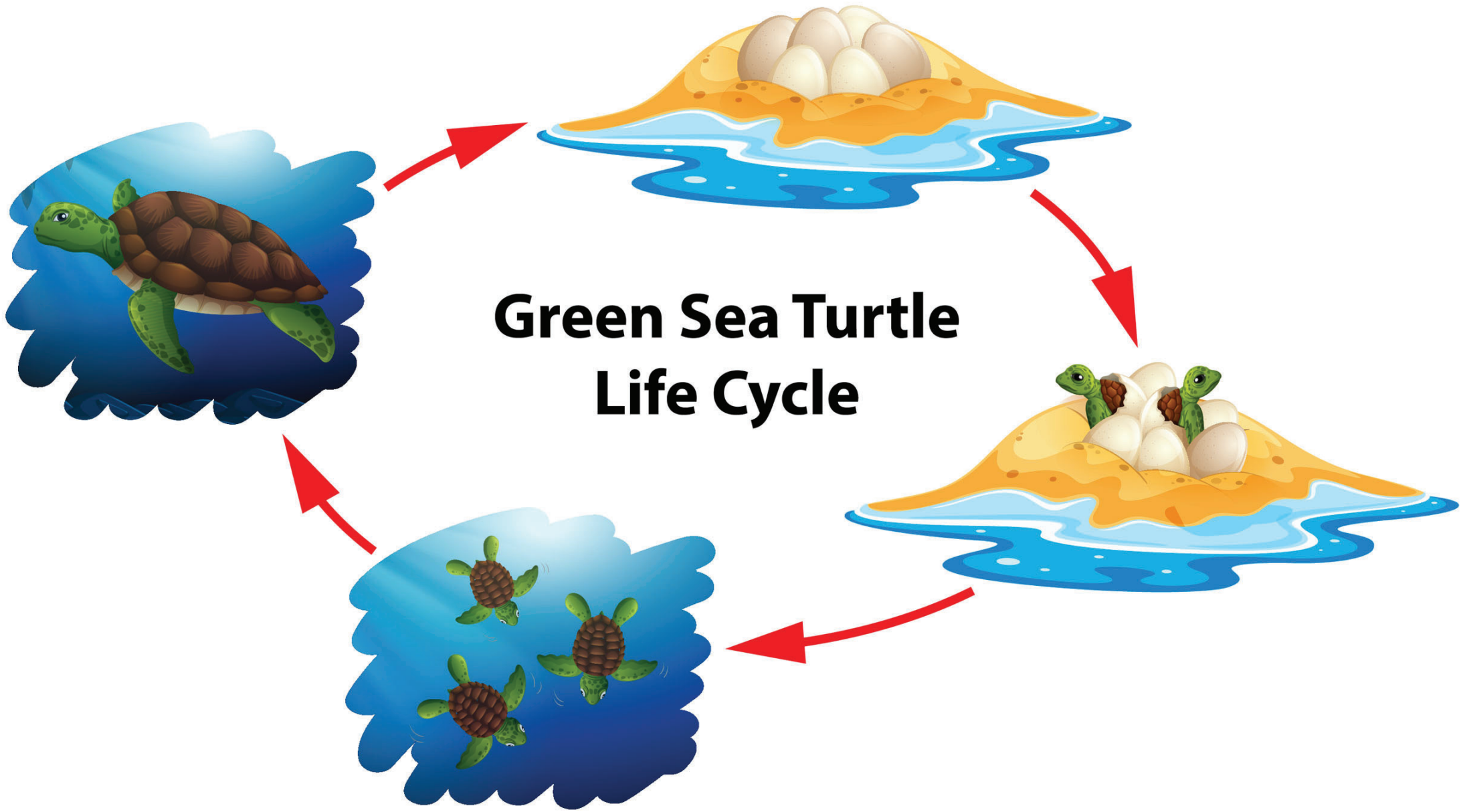
Frog Life Cycle

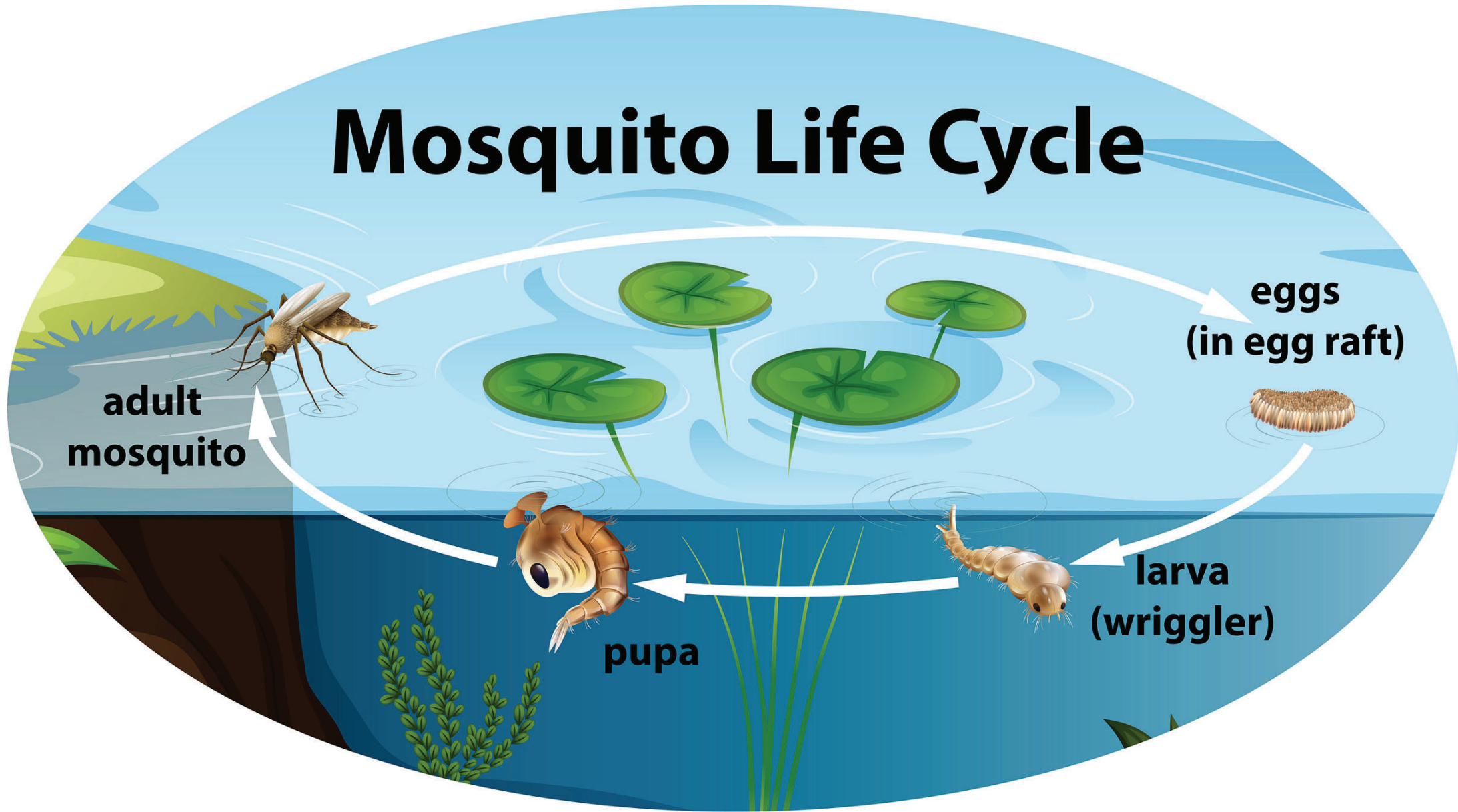
Mosquito Life Cycle

Moth Life Cycle



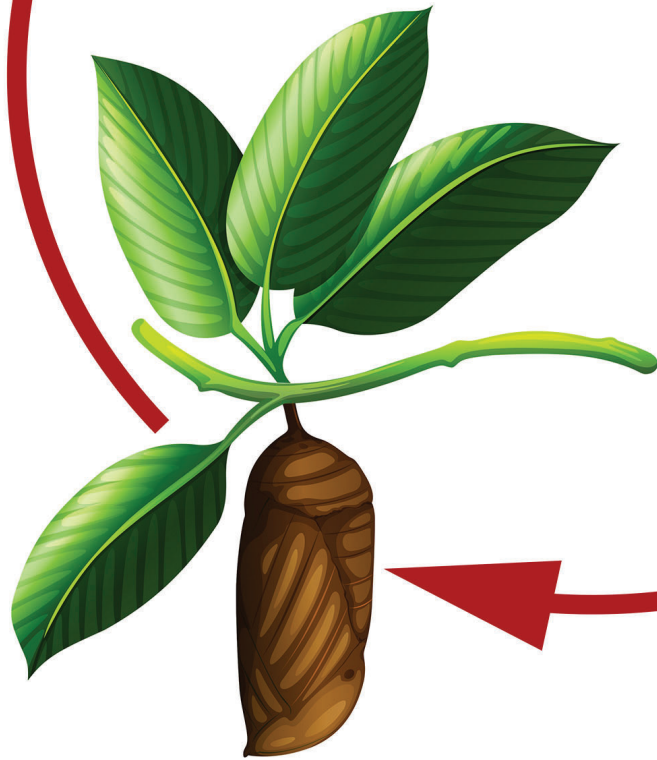

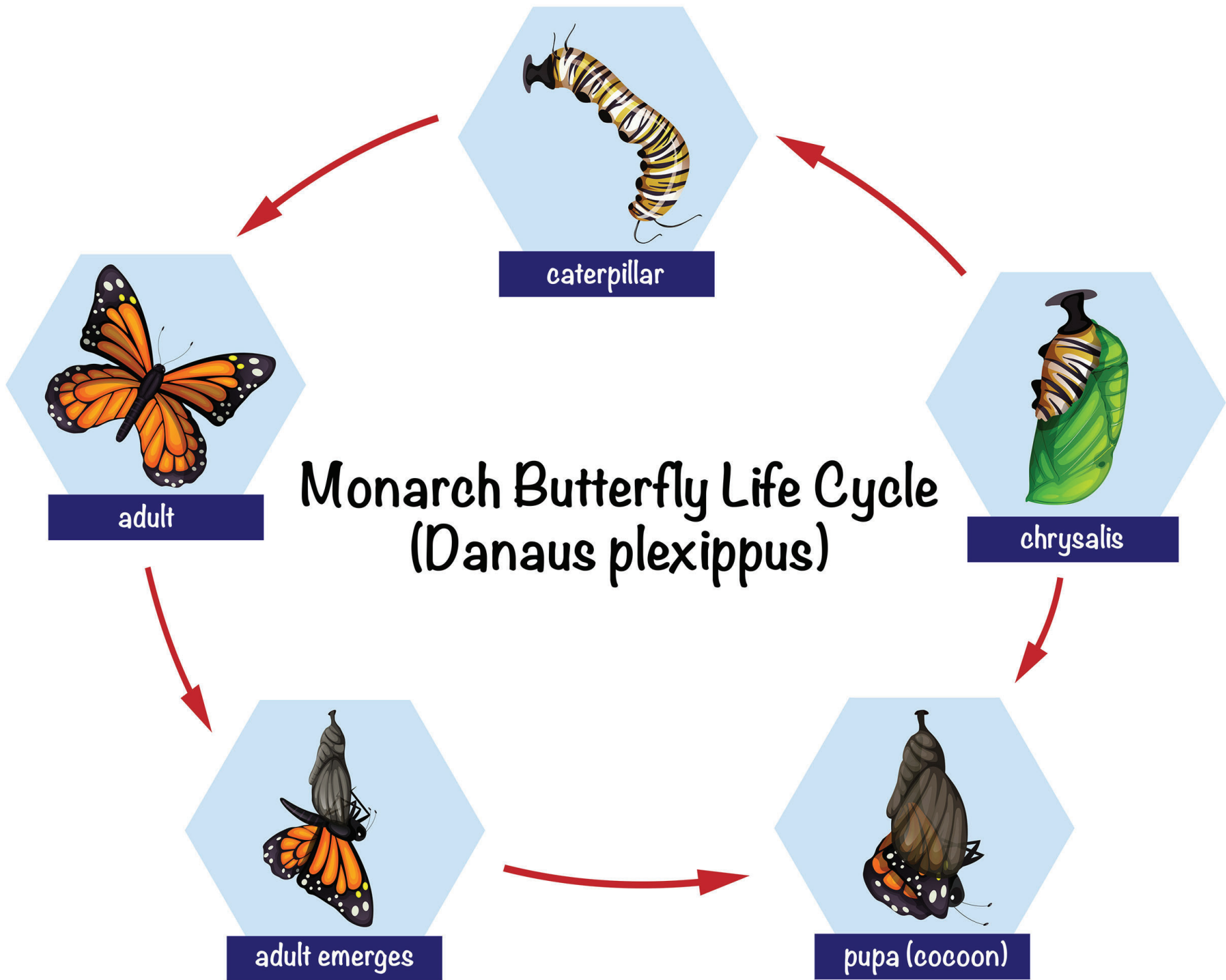

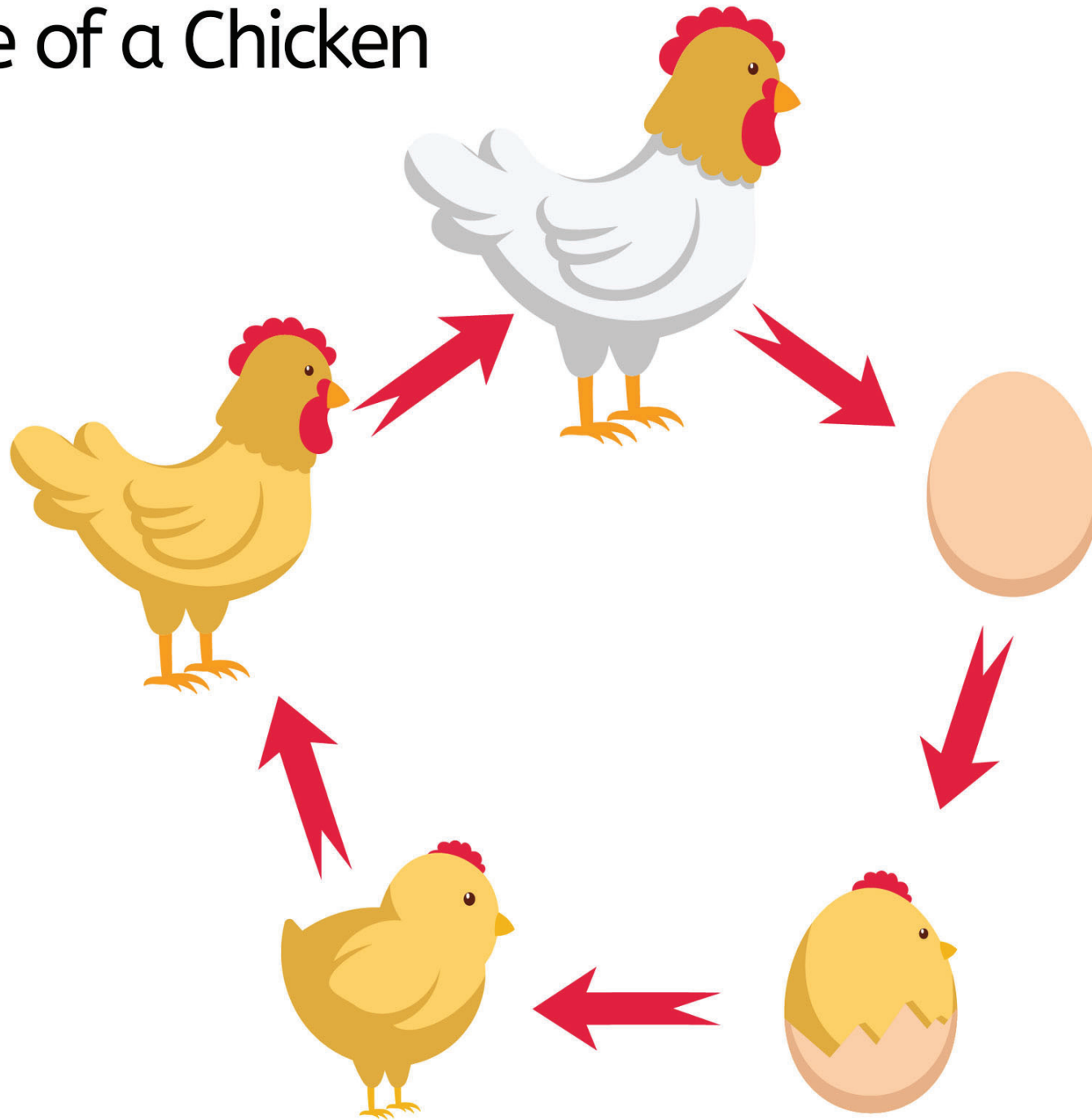

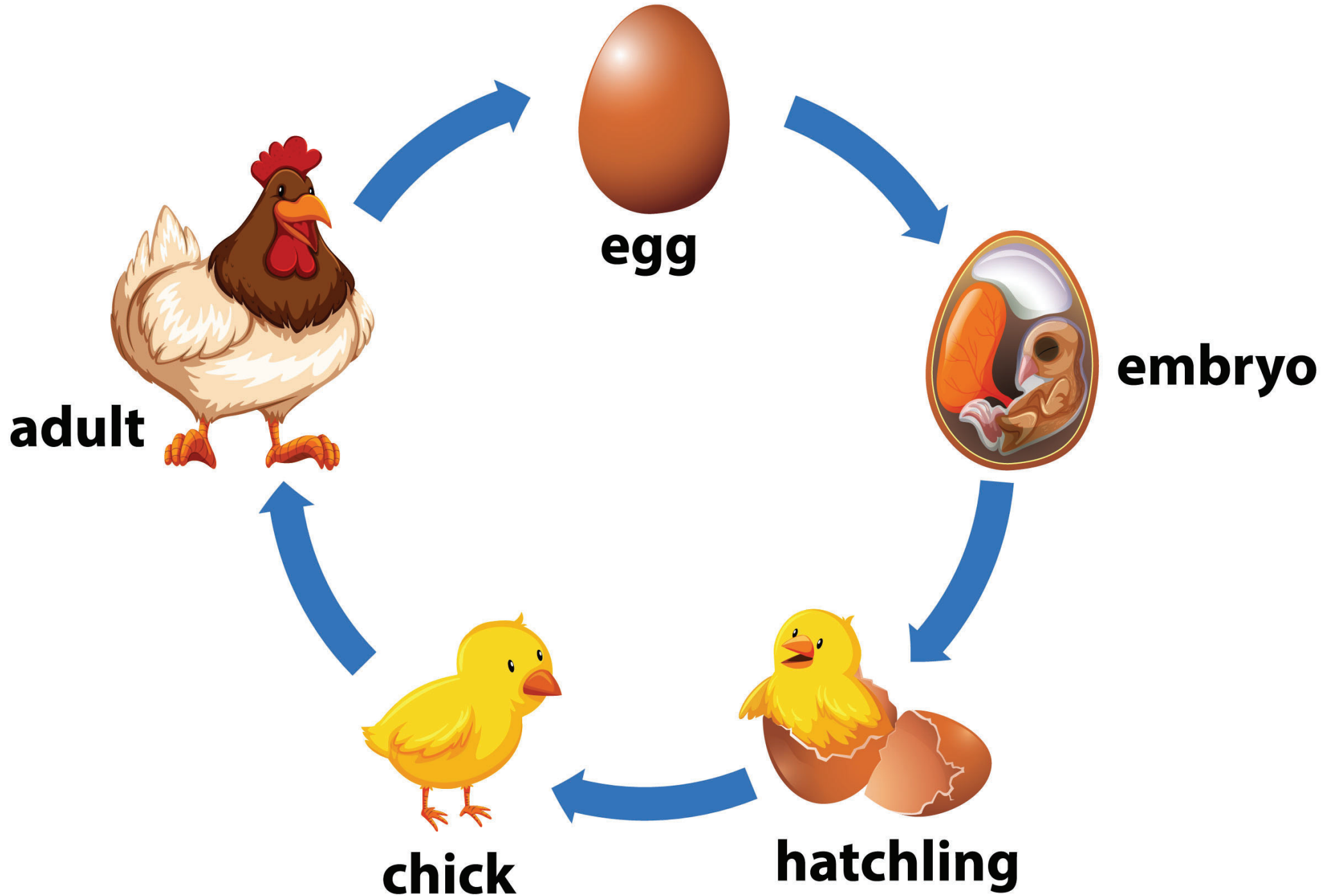




Life Cycle of a Chicken

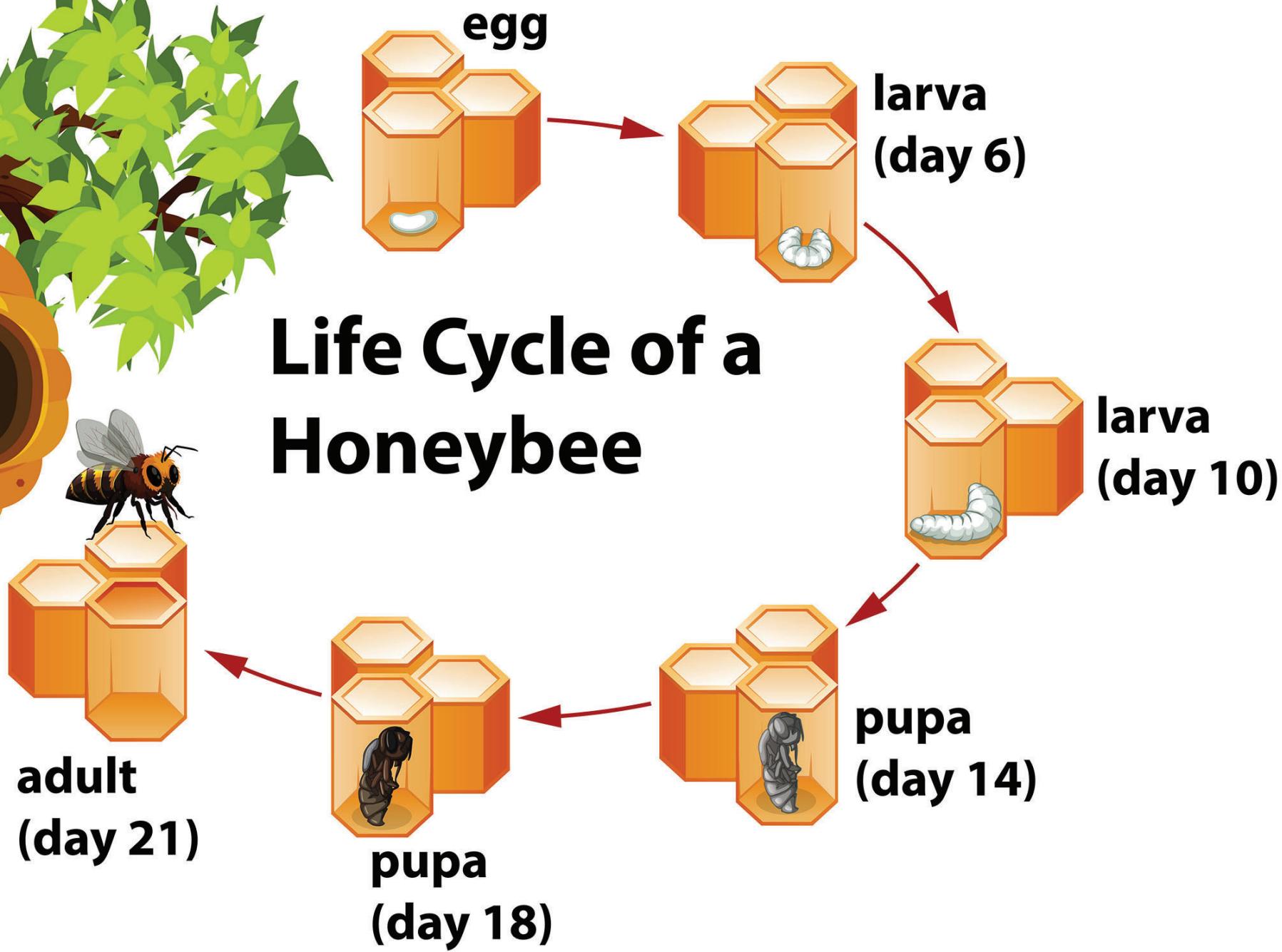


Chicken Life Cycle

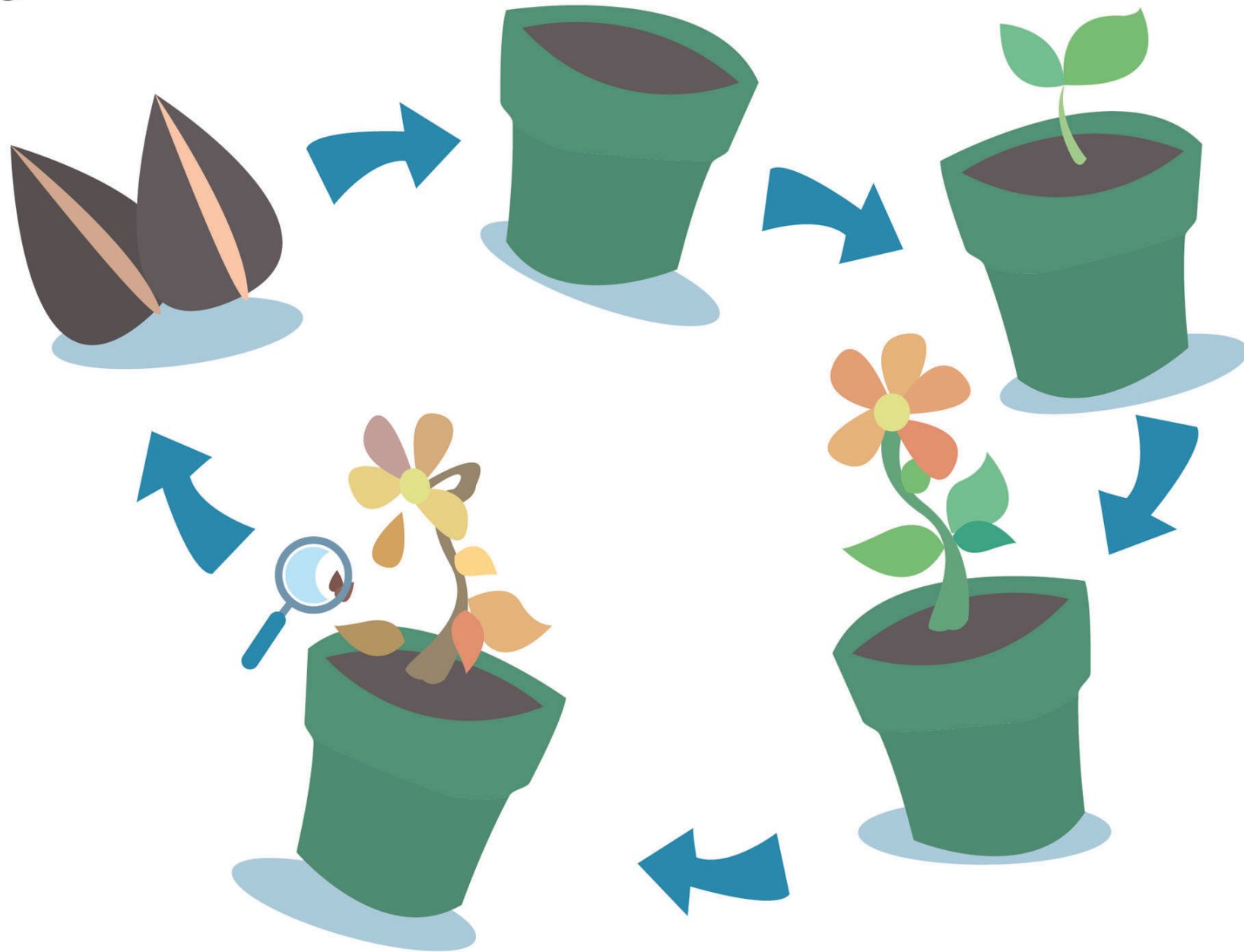


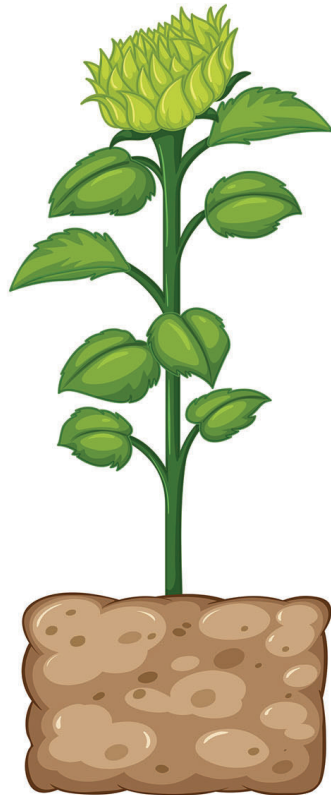
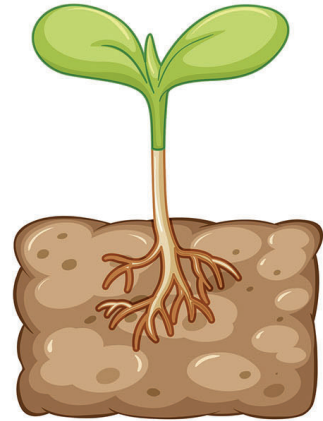


Life Cycle of a Honeybee
