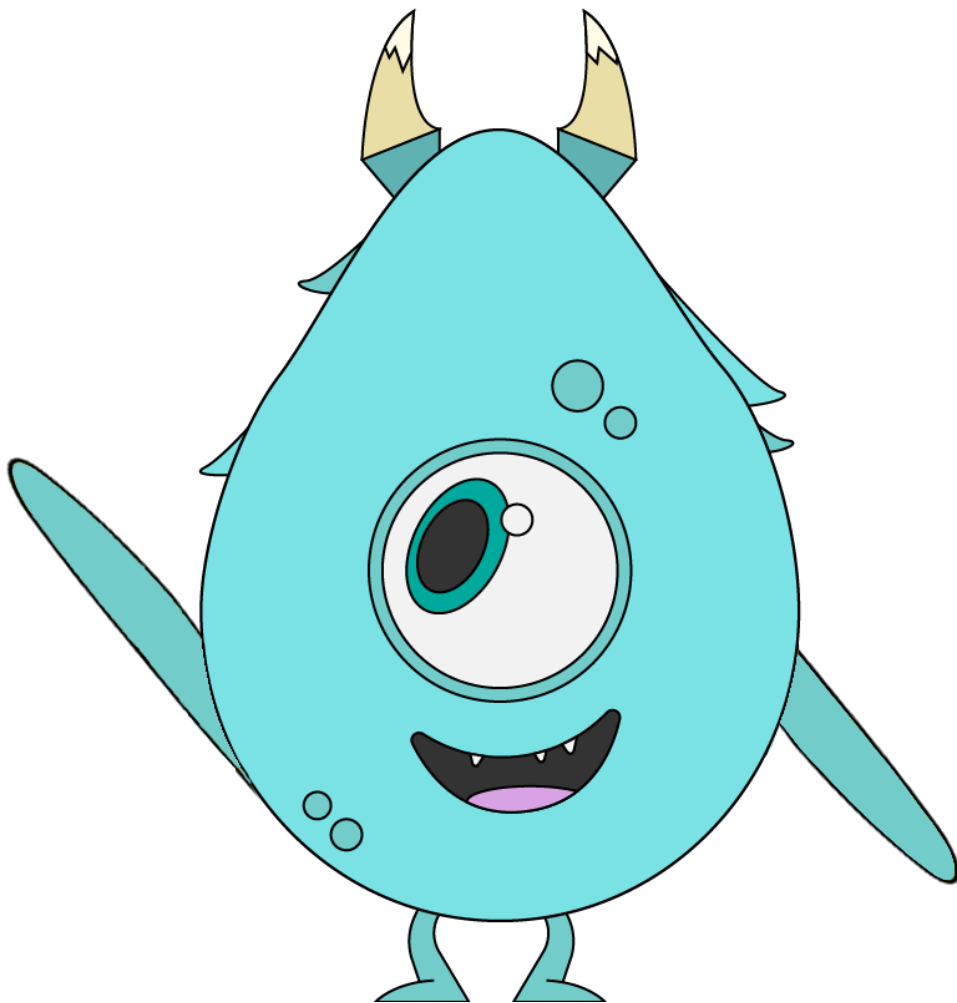


Learning Intention

We will imagine the story as if it is really happening. This is called visualising.

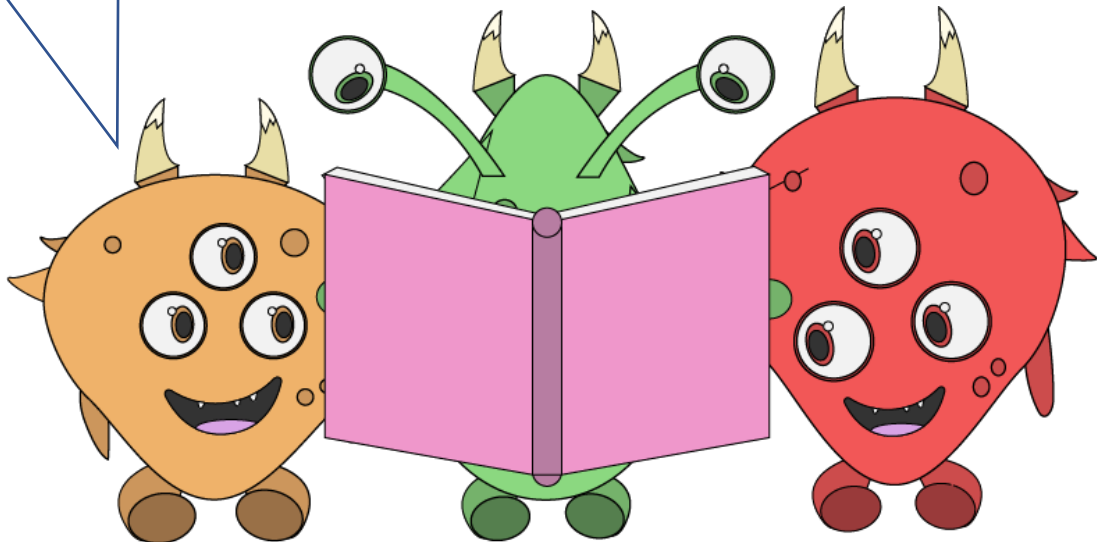


Success Criteria

I will think about the words and pictures and say what I can see, hear, smell, taste or feel.

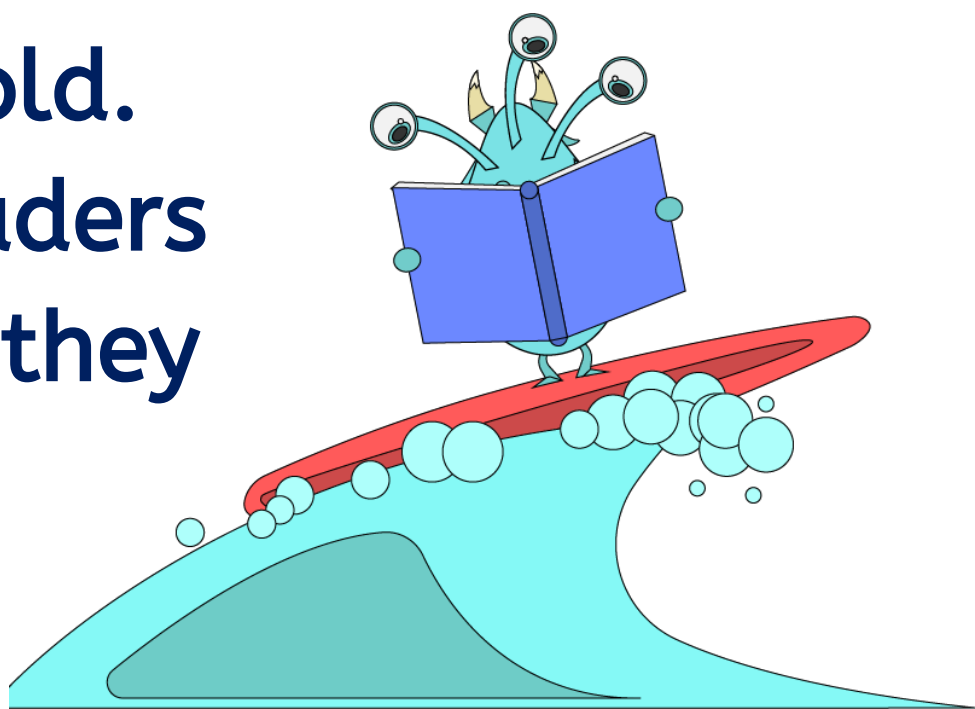

Visualising






