
Learning Intention I am learning to notice when time jumps forward in a story. That means time goes from now to a time in the future that hasn't yet happened.

I will find a part of the story where a flashforward happens. A flashforward is where the story jumps from now to a time in the future.



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Flashbacks & Flashforwards

A flashback is where a story jumps from now to a time in the past, or a time that has already happened.

A flashforward is where a story jumps from now to a time in the future, or a time that has not happened yet.

Authors use flashbacks and flashforwards to give readers a glimse of something that has already happened or which could or does happen at a later time.

Flashbacks and flashforwards are used to help readers to understand why things are happening.
