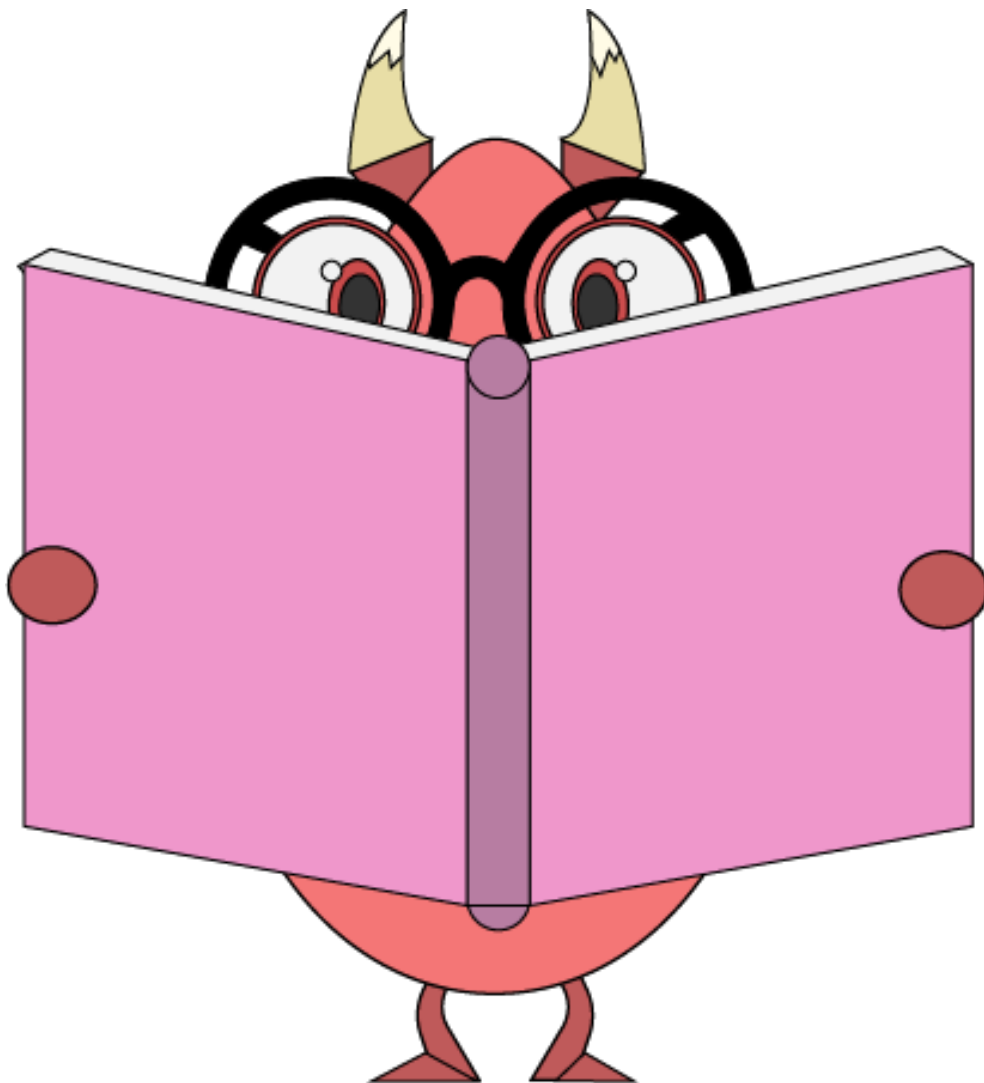


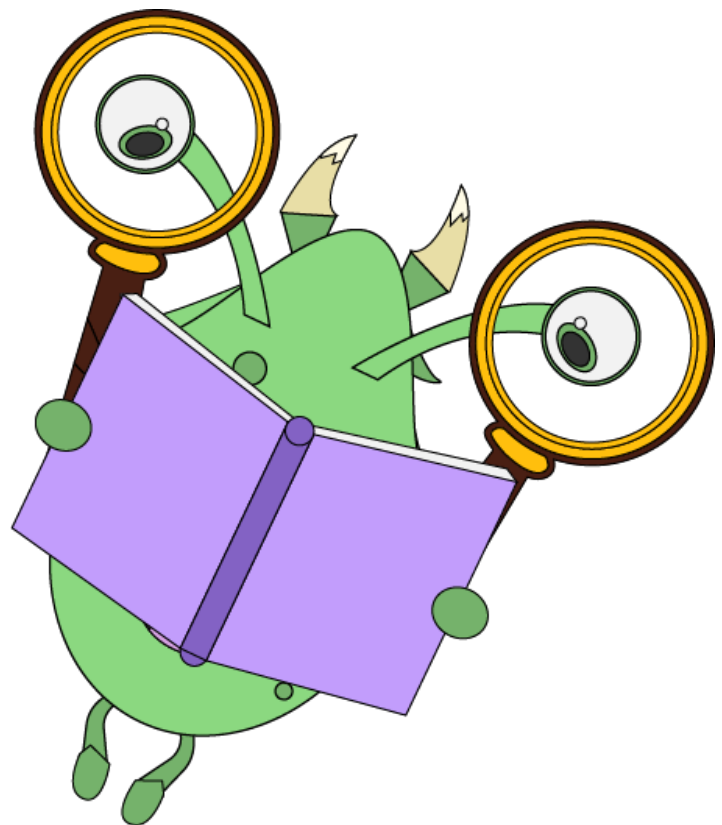
Learning Intention

I will think about what the story is about and what lesson I could learn from the characters and how they act. I will share my ideas.

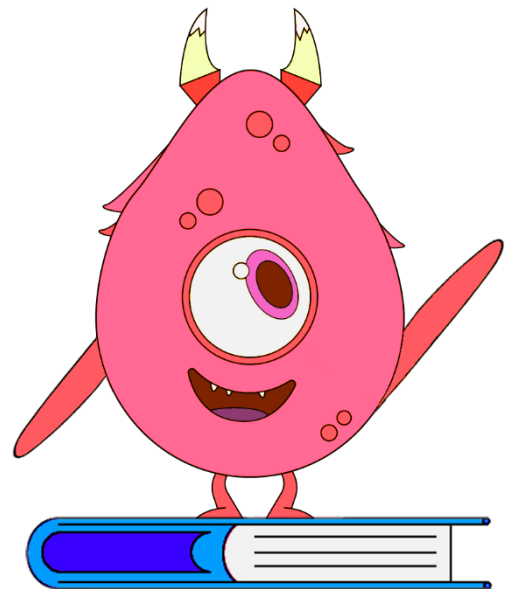


Moral

The moral of a story is the life lesson readers learn.

Readers learn the lesson by thinking about how the characters act and how they solve problems. To work out the moral, ask yourself:

“What is the important lesson I should learn from this?”



“How does this story help me to know how to act?”
