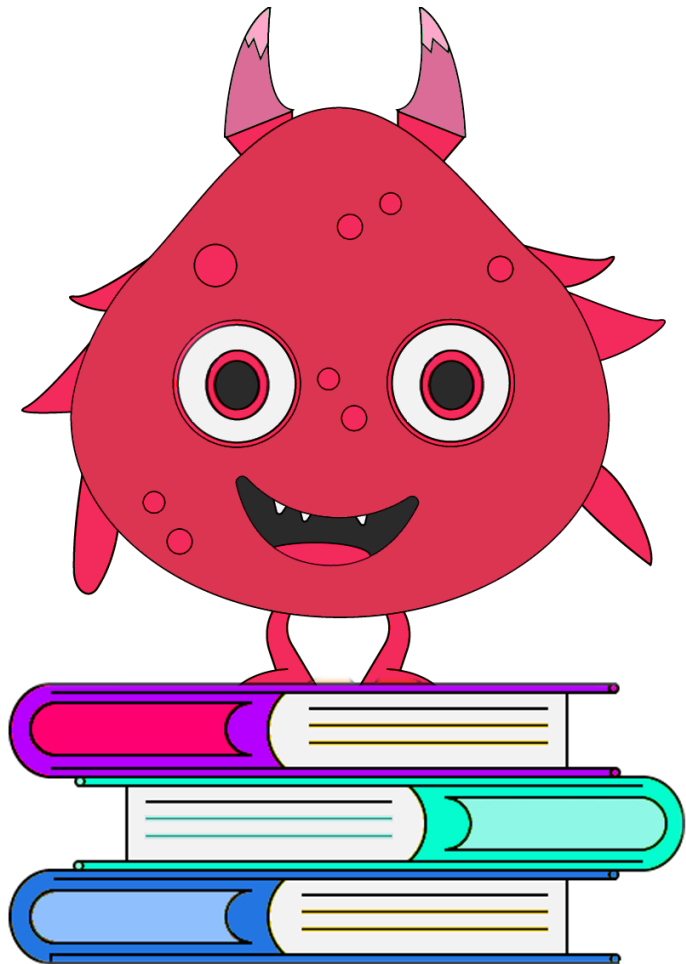


Learning Intention

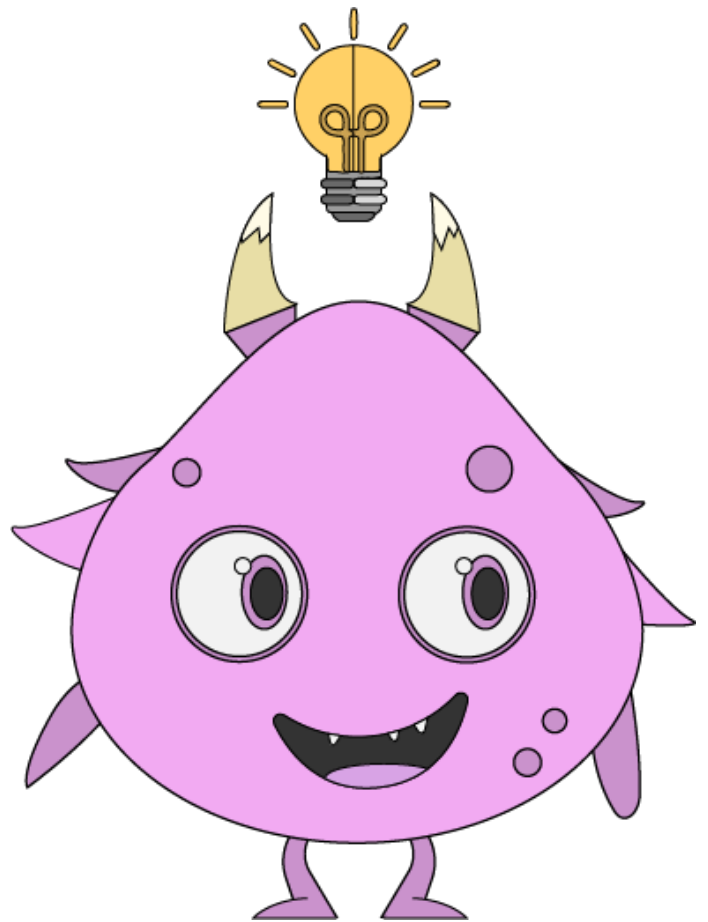
I am learning to make judgments about what I am reading and support them with evidence from the text.

I will use evidence in the text to support my opinion.

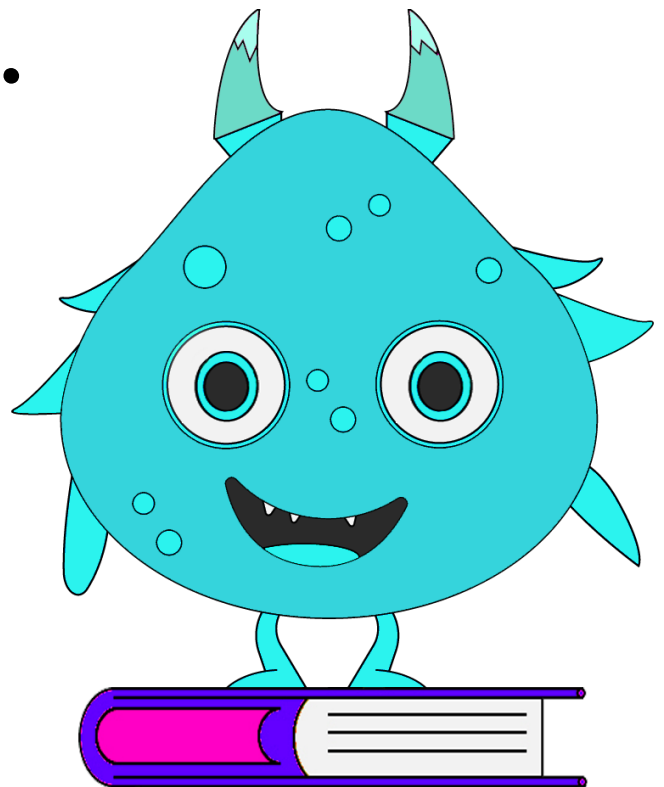


Making Judgments

A judgment is an opinion that is formed by thinking carefully about something and deciding whether you think it is **right** or **wrong**.

When skilful readers make judgments, they notice what is being said or done. This is called **evidence**.

They use the evidence to justify or give reasons for their thinking.
