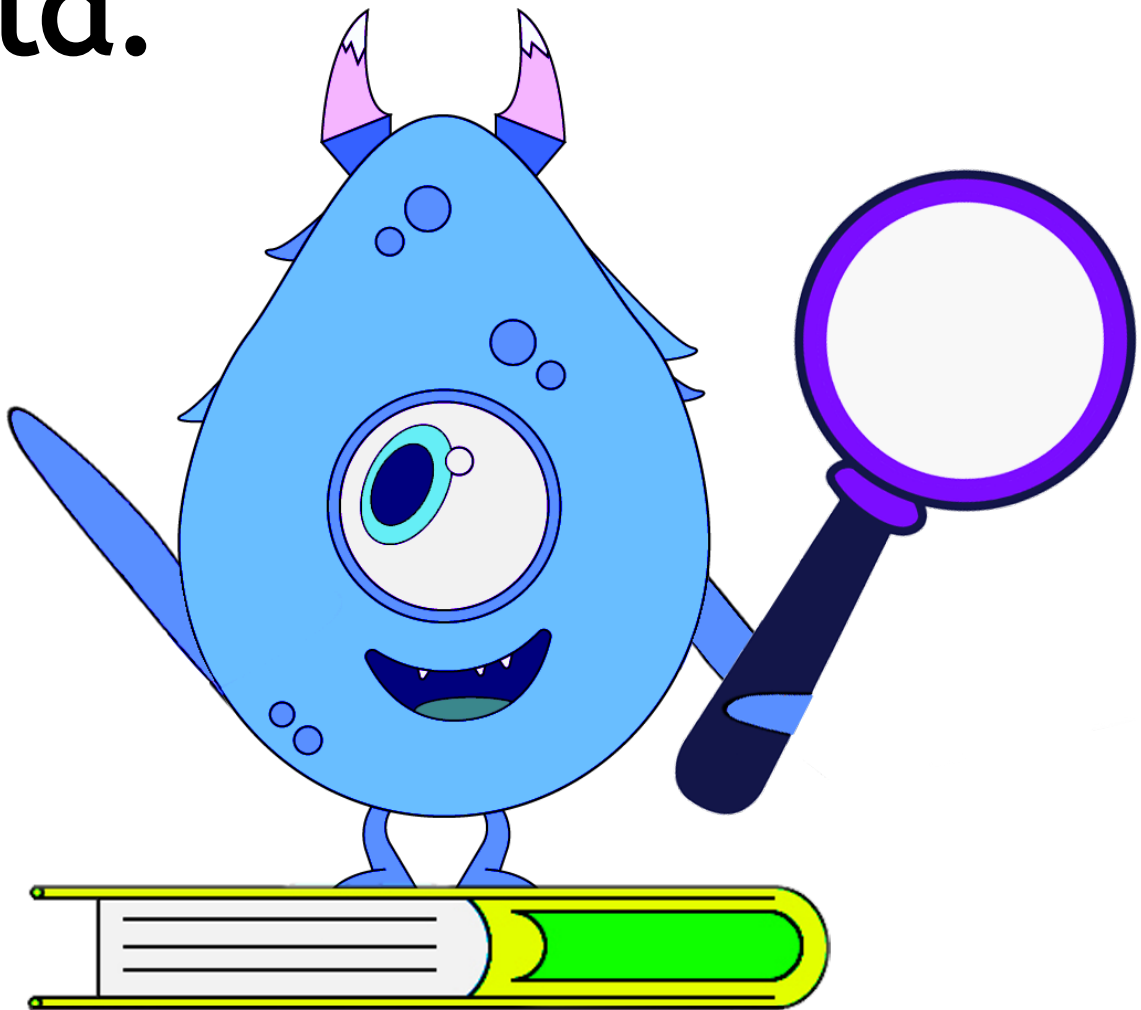


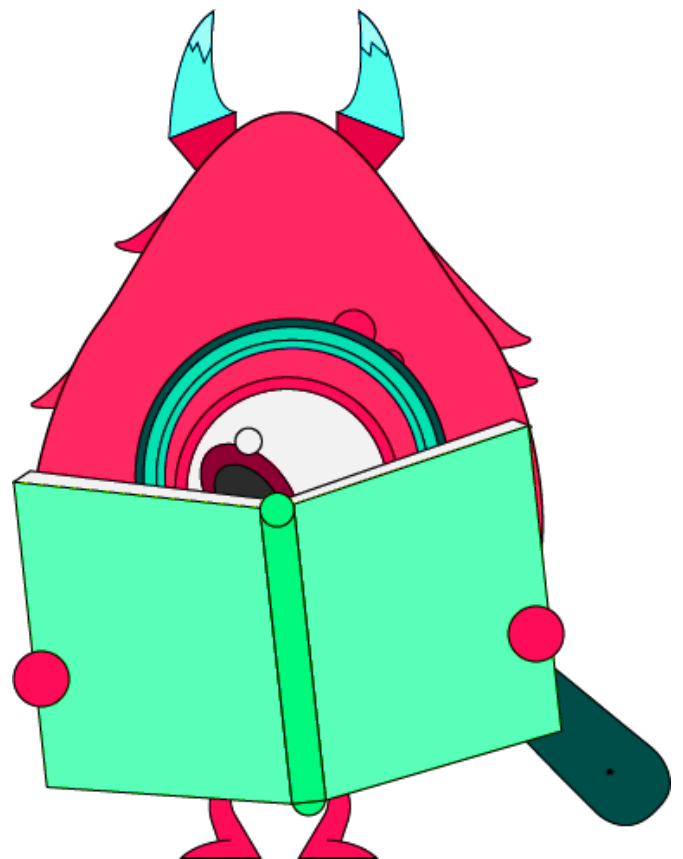
Learning Intention

Success Criteria

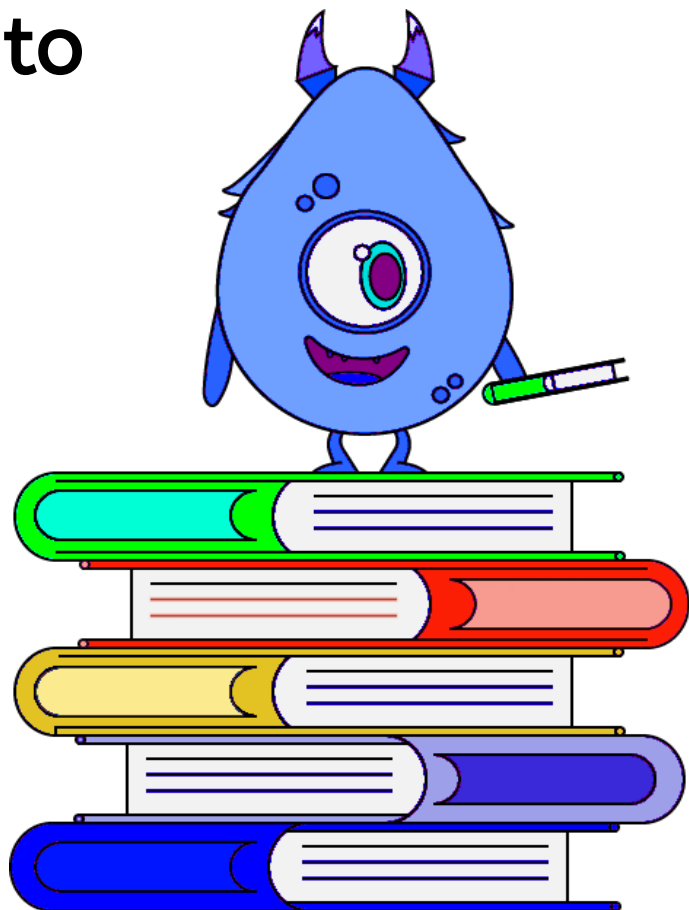
I will listen to the story and work out whether the storyteller is someone in the story, or someone not in the story. I will find evidence to prove my thinking.



Perspective

Great readers can figure out who is telling the story. Sometimes the storyteller is a character in the story. Sometimes the story is told or narrated by someone not in the story. It is like they are watching the story.

Identifying who is telling the story helps readers to know whose perspective or point of view the story is told from.
